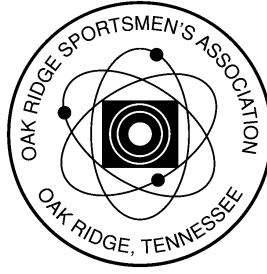

CIVILIAN MARKSMANSHIP PROGRAM (CMP) SERVICE RIFLE CLINIC **APRIL 18, 2020, 8:00 AM - ORSA ED T. JOHNSON INDOOR RANGE FACILITY**

The ORSA Rifle and Pistol Club will conduct its second Spring 2020 CMP Service Rifle Clinic of the 2020 shooting season on April 18th, 2020. You will learn to fire a Service Rifle accurately without the need for sand bags or a bipod. It's not magic, or an unattainable skill. ORSA High Power Service Rifle and Long-Range Rifle shooters routinely place 20 shots in groups smaller than the size of a dinner plate at 600 yards. You will receive one-on-one instruction from experienced competitors.

If you would like to learn how to get started in the high-power service rifle shooting disciplines, please plan to join us on Saturday, April 18th at 8:00 AM at ORSA's Ed T. Johnson Indoor Range Facility. You may bring your own US Service Rifle (AR-15, M1-Garand, or M1-A and ammo); or, use a club rifle and ammo. If you bring your gear, cost is \$5.00. If you are using an ORSA rifle, ammo, and equipment; cost is \$30.00.

If you wish to participate, please read and follow the instructions below.

ANSWER THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:

- What is your name, email address, and are you 12 or older?
- Are you furnishing your own rifle and ammo? If you are, what are you bringing? (see safety)
- Will you need a club AR-15? (note, only club ammo may be fired in club rifles)
- What is your suit jacket size? (helps us fit you with a shooting jacket)
- Are you left-handed?

PLEASE READ AND FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS:

- Schedule: Report to the ORSA Ed T. Johnson Indoor Range Facility at 8:00 AM Saturday, the day of the Clinic.
- You will register, receive an introductory course of instruction and will be assigned a shooting relay and target number
- Upon reporting to the firing line, you will be paired with a coach and fitted with a shooting jacket and mitt.

COURSE OF FIRE: ALL FIRING WILL BE CONDUCTED FROM THE 200 YARD LINE

- 5 prone slow fire sighter shots
- 10 shots prone slow fire
- 10 shots rapid fire fired from the prone position with a magazine change
- 10 shots rapid fire fired from the sitting position with a magazine change
- 10 shots slow fire standing

FEES: (CASH ONLY, PLEASE)

- \$30.00 for club rifle, ammo, and equipment
- \$5.00 if participant brings their own rifle, equipment and ammo

RANGE REQUIREMENTS, SAFETY, AND COMFORT:

- Eye and Ear Protection are required on all ORSA ranges and must be furnished by participants.
- Dress for the weather predicted, to include a hat and sunscreen. An inclement weather plan exists in the event of rain.
- No Muzzle Brakes, shooters and coaches are in close proximity to each other on the firing line.
- Bring plenty to drink, and a light lunch

HIGH POWER RANGE USE

One of the great things about the ORSA facility is the number of different ranges and options we can provide to the members but with that also comes some challenges. Due to the different ranges we have, it's nearly impossible to cover all the different rules and etiquette for each range and their use, in any type of orientation or briefing. This is the reason we encourage someone who would like to use a specific range to join in with like-minded users of that particular range so they can learn the rules and any specific needs for that range. This issue is never more important, than using the High Power and Long Ranges available at ORSA.

These two ranges have specific safety rules for verifying that the down range area is safe, closing gates, putting up flags and other requirements before the range can "go hot". The differences occur due to the fact that you can't see in to the pits area, where the pond is located, without physically driving down to that area. Putting the "range hot" flag up at the 600 yard line, then closing the appropriate gates on the pit road prevents someone from driving in to an area that has been designated as off limits when firing is taking place. The rules for this range and its proper usage are detailed on the sign posted at the 600 yard line parking lot.

HIGH POWER RIFLE COMPETITION RANGE

The High Power (HP) Rifle Competition Range is used for organized ORSA-sponsored tournaments, leagues, and training clinics. When not scheduled for sanctioned events, the HP Rifle Competition Range may be used by qualified ORSA members for competition practice. Qualified members must hold a competitor classification card in at least one NRA rifle discipline, or must have a current CMP competitor number. Non-qualified ORSA members may use the HP Rifle Competition Range only when accompanied and supervised by a qualified ORSA Rifle and Pistol Club member. This HP Rifle Competition Range is widely recognized as one of the premier HP competition venues in the Nation. To protect ORSA's investment and to prevent damage to this facility, all other casual, non-competition shooting is strictly prohibited.

Safety
SAFETY IS THE TOP PRIORITY!
ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION OR USE OF ANY DRUG IMPAIRING JUDGEMENT (ANYWHERE ON THE HP RANGE COMPLEX) IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN. FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EXPULSION FROM THE RANGE AND REVOCATION OF ORSA MEMBERSHIP.

All range usage will be governed by current ORSA range safety regulations. All uncased rifles must be on Safe, have magazines removed, and bolts open with an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) inserted before they can be handled on the range.

It is mandatory that the Fishing Pond be inspected and cleared before firing. Shooting takes precedence over fishing. Firing may take place only from the numbered firing points on the marked firing lines at 200, 300, 600, 800, 900, and 1000 yards.

During live firing, the range road must be blocked by closing the red access control gate at the firing line currently in use. The red "range hot" flag must be run up the flag pole closest to the pit's access road on the 600-yard line.

When firing at ranges exceeding 600 yards, users must also close the red access control gate leading to and from the Action Pistol Range complex on the eastern side of the range.

During firing, pit personnel must remain between their target carrier and the pit wall at all times.

Rifles
Only centerfire rifles less than .50 caliber are authorized.

Ammunition
Armor piercing, tracer, or any incendiary round are prohibited.

Targets
Only paper targets sanctioned for NRA or CMP competitions may be used. No other targets are authorized. Practice targets must be mounted on one of the 6' by 6' cardboard-backed target frames kept for practice firing under the shooter attached to the right side of the locked shed where competition targets and supplies are stored in the pits.

The target frame must be mounted only in the target carrier numbered the same as the firing point in use. Cross firing is prohibited.

Targets may not be placed on the ground between firing lines or on the pit safety berm. Targets may not be attached to target number boards, flag poles, range control gates, or any range structure.

Vehicles
VEHICLES MAY NOT BE DRIVEN ON OR ACROSS THE GRASS FIRING LINES OR BEHIND THE TARGET PITS.
Vehicles must be parked in the graveled parking areas behind the 300 and 600-yard lines. Competitors may unload their equipment at the 200-yard line so long as they remain off of the firing line.

The second item we should cover for the HP and LR ranges is target use and etiquette. The targets and frames for these two ranges are specifically sized to fit in to the targets carriers which must be used when firing on these

the holes up from their shots. At the very least they should have pasted the holes, but the ideal situation would have been for this person to take a used target from the outside building to the right of the target shed that has already

had the center shot out, and placed their orange targets on that target, rather than an used one. If occurrence like this continue to happen or increase, the combination on the target shed may need to be changed and this would eliminate the use of the HP and LR ranges to everyone but the HP and LR competitors, and this wouldn't be fair to the rest of the members. If you see someone not using target etiquette or using these ranges in a manner different than what they are intended to be, bring it to their attention (kindly and with proper language) and report it the range staff listed on the sign at the 600 yard line.

Target etiquette can also come in to play in this area, what does target etiquette mean you ask? The targets designed for HP and LR are designed to be shot in the center and are constructed of a cardboard backer to hold the paper targets in place. As you can see in the example below, someone took a brand new target from the target house and proceeded to use it for load development by shooting at the orange stick on targets. Once completed, they put the target back in to the shed in this manner, without pasting

FACTCHECK PROVIDES COVER FOR BIDEN AND BETO'S GUN CONTROL PLANS

The website Factcheck.org is out with what's supposedly a debunking of claims that Joe Biden's embraced Robert Francis "Beto" O'Rourke's gun ban and compensated confiscation plans, but the supposed fact checkers are only telling half of the story.

Here's what Factcheck got right: Joe Biden's gun control agenda, as outlined on his website, does not call for the confiscation of so-called assault weapons. Instead, under Biden's proposal, all existing owners of "assault weapons" would be required to register their firearms and "high capacity magazines" under the National Firearms

Act. Those who did not choose to do so could also sell their firearms to the government as part of a "buyback." Anyone found to be in possession of a banned firearm or magazine that wasn't registered under the National Firearms Act could be charged with a federal crime.

However, even though Biden's plan doesn't spell out a confiscation strategy, that's exactly what it would amount to in many cases. It costs \$200 to register an item through the National Firearms Act, and forcing gun owners to pay \$200 to the government to maintain possession of each of their banned guns and magazines would be cost prohibitive for many Americans. Instead, they'd be compelled to turn over their guns and magazines or else risk federal felony charges in the future. Violations of the National Firearms Act can be punished by up to ten years in federal prison, so we're not talking about a minor fine. You could spend a decade behind bars simply for maintaining possession of a gun or magazine that you legally purchased under Biden's plan.

Obviously there are grave constitutional concerns over Biden's gun grab, but there are some practical problems with it as well. Biden's gun control plan doesn't define a "high capacity magazine," but it's fair to say that whether it's defined as a magazine than can hold more than 10, 15, or 20 rounds, that will cover hundreds of millions of magazines and the vast majority of the nation's legal gun owners.

It can already take months to get NFA approval for a single item, so if tens of millions of gun owners are trying to register hundreds of millions of magazines, the system will simply be overwhelmed. How do gun owners register magazines under the NFA to begin with, given that magazines aren't firearms and aren't serialized?

Honestly, Biden's plan is so complicated and inherently flawed that I wouldn't be surprised to see him adopt O'Rourke's simpler (if equally unconstitutional) plan to simply ban all semi-automatic long guns and "high capacity" magazines and have a mandatory compensated confiscation program.

Biden hasn't done that yet, however. When Factcheck.org reached out to the Biden campaign for "clarification" about his comments that O'Rourke would be leading his gun control efforts, this is what they received in response.

"Vice President Biden is the sole candidate in the race who has beaten the NRA — twice. The epidemic of gun violence that is wracking communities across our nation is a full-blown moral and safety crisis, especially for our children. He's honored to have Beto O'Rourke's endorsement, and is thrilled that Beto will be leading grassroots support for the Vice President's gun reform proposals that we absolutely can't afford not to make as soon as possible. It's vital that the next president be able to take on and defeat the gun manufacturers and their lobby, and Joe Biden is the only candidate with the right background and credentials to do so."

O'Rourke himself, on the other hand, is still talking up gun confiscation.

If Biden's point man on gun control is still calling for a "mandatory buyback," then I think it's fair to say that's what he's going to be pushing Biden to do. Factcheck may be accurate in stating that Biden has made no commitment to adopting O'Rourke's proposal, but clearly O'Rourke himself thinks it's still a possibility.

Whether O'Rourke gets his way or not is largely irrelevant, given the unconstitutional proposal put forth by Biden. Either plan, if enacted, would strip Americans of their right to own the most commonly produced rifle in the country. Both plans would make it a felony to possess the most commonly owned magazines in the country. Both plans would violate the constitutional rights of Americans, and I suspect both plans would be met with a great deal of non-compliance.

WHERE THEY STAND

Buttigieg stated the president is partially responsible for criminal misuse of firearms, and among other goals supports universal background checks, a ban on so-called "assault weapons" and standard capacity magazines, and instituting "red-flag" laws that deny due process to citizens. Each of these solutions has been called "dubious" as none have shown how they'll reduce crime. They will only infringe on the rights of those who follow the law.

Sen. Sanders is running as far and as fast as he can from the views he once espoused. He voted for the Protection of Lawful Commerce in Arms Act (PLCAA). Just two weeks ago, though, the self-described democratic socialist said, "I certainly have changed" when it comes to guns. Sen. Sanders also favors a ban on modern sporting rifles and standard capacity magazines and wants a national universal background check system, which would only work if it included a national registry, which is forbidden by law.

Sen. Warren, along with her general "plans" for every other issue offered the same on guns, stating numerous proposals, specifically looking to punish the firearms and ammunition industry by raising taxes on gun manufacturers, from 10 to 30 percent on firearms and ammunition from 11 to 50 percent. Warren also wants a national firearms licensing scheme, federal waiting period to purchase firearms, a ban on modern sporting rifles, suppressors and magazines, repealing PLCAA and hold exposing firearms company executives to jail time through her expanded definitions of negligence.

Even fourth-place former Vice President Biden's proposed gun control plan "would make the biggest changes to U.S. gun laws in decades," including expanded universal background checks, a ban on modern sporting rifles and a requirement for "James Bond-style DNA and fingerprint match" in order to pull the trigger.

Sliding under the radar was the anti-gun billionaire Michael Bloomberg, funder of Moms Demand Action and Everytown for Gun Safety. The former New York City mayor declined to play in Iowa caucuses and because of that, he's able to stay above the fray, point to the mess and separate himself from the debacle. His campaign announced they were doubling their \$300 million advertising buy, pushing the spending to over a half-billion to spread his gun control message. SCOTUS TAKES UP CASE ON RIGHT TO BEAR ARMS

The U.S. Supreme Court will hear arguments in the case New York State Rifle & Pistol Association v. City of New York. This will be the first Second Amendment case the High Court has heard in nearly 10 years following its landmark rulings in Heller (2008) and McDonald (2010). The case involves New York City's passage of a gun-control law banning gun-owning residents from transporting their firearms outside their homes and outside city limits, except to select gun ranges within the city and only then provided their handguns are unloaded, locked up, and separate from ammunition. In other words, paper weights that are useless for self-defense.

The draconian and obviously unconstitutional law was immediately challenged by Second Amendment advocates. In a move clearly demonstrating that New York officials knew their law violates the Second Amendment, they sought to prevent the issue from being taken up by the Supreme Court by changing the law to allow gun-owning residents to transport their firearms outside city limits provided it was "directly to and from" a second home or shooting range.

However, this "voluntary cessation" didn't stop the justices from deciding to hear the case, as they rightly note that the issue at stake is the Second Amendment's protection of individuals' right to bear and not merely possess arms. Furthermore, New York officials are clearly seeking to undermine the Heller decision, which protects the right to bear firearms for the "core lawful purpose of self-defense," as well as "learning to handle and use [arms]" and "hunting." By limiting a gun owner's right to bear firearms only in his place of residence, New York was effectively attempting to gut Heller, which is likely why the justices are keen to take up this case to reassert the Court's judicial authority. Clarence Thomas, for one, has been particularly vocal about the erosion of the Second Amendment by municipalities and lower courts.

Predictably, the anti-gun crowd isn't happy. Democrat Sen. Sheldon Whitehouse (RI) warned the Court that if it did not drop the case, he and his fellow Democrats would work to "restructure" the Court. "The Supreme Court is not well. And the people know it," Whitehouse ridiculously asserted. He added, "Perhaps the Court can heal itself before the public demands it be 'restructured in order to reduce the influence of politics.' Particularly on the urgent issue of gun control, a nation desperately needs it to heal." Oh, the irony. Who exactly is seeking to inject "the influence of politics" into the Court in order to eliminate Americans' Second Amendment rights? It certainly isn't the NRA or Republicans.

If the Court follows the precedent it set with Heller, it's likely that the ruling will come down to a 5-4 decision. No wonder anti-Second Amendment activists are so upset over the Court's decision to hear the case.
