### OAK RIDGE SPORTSMEN'S ASSOCIATION AND NATIONAL SPORTING CLAYS ASSOCIATION 2020 YOUTH SPORTING CLAYS CAMP

The Oak Ridge Sportsmen's Association in partnership with the National Sporting Clays Association, conducted its 2nd annual 2-day Youth Sporting Clays Camp, June 23 & 24 at ORSA Sporting Clays facility, in Oak Ridge TN.

Twenty youth athletes ages 12-16 participated in the camp. Six NSCA certified instructors, Level I- III, including 4 new Level 1 ORSA members, instructed these youth athletes on proper stance, gun mount and advanced techniques to help them become better Sporting Clays shooters.

They also provided a gun fit session before the camp began to ensure the athletes had the proper gun fit to make them more successful in Sporting Clays.

Lead Level III instructor, Mike Bates said:

"Having organized and led four youth camps, I have discovered the key to a successful camp lies with the host club. Oak Ridge Sportsmen's Association is 100% behind youth development through safe and responsible training of our future sporting clay shooters."

Safety briefings were held each morning before they headed to the course. And as Safety is always the first priority of the camp, there were range safety officers assigned on the course to provide a safe and fun environment.

Bill Smith NSCA Level III Instructor, commented, "The ORSA/NSCA Youth Sporting Clays Camp was a great success! With assistance from the new NSCA Level 1 Instructors from ORSA, we were able to conduct smaller groups and allow for each shooter to learn the

fundamentals of shooting sporting clays. The program was a great success!"

Shotgun Athlete Jonathon Warlick said,

"Working with the instructors at the ORSA camp helped me to fine tune my shooting and get the second highest score of all intermediate shooters at the Tennessee SCTP state championships. The clinic was so much fun and so was doing so well at state!"

The two-day clinic consisted of various target presentations to ensure that the athletes were given the opportunity to shoot stations they might encounter at a Sporting Clays event. The last part of the second day gave the athletes the chance to shoot the entire Sporting Clays course.

Athlete Justin Umbarger commented,

"The sporting clays camp was a big help in helping me meet my goals. The instructors made sure that I was looking back toward the trap and bringing the stock to my face. We worked on my gun mount. This and many more things helped me in the Tennessee STCP state tournament. I tied for second in sporting clays and came in second in skeet in my division. I enjoyed the camp and will be going again next year."

The athletes had plenty of practice, with ORSA throwing nearly 8,000 Whiteflyer targets from our MEC sporting clays machines during the camp.

Athletes and instructors also received an ORSA-NSCA Sporting Clays tee shirt. The 2021 ORSA-NSCA Sporting Clays Youth Camp is now being planned and the date will be announced soon.

## RECENT ACHIEVEMENTS BY OUR SHOTGUN ATHLETES AT STATE & NATIONAL LEVEL

Success, is defined as “the accomplishment of an aim or purpose”. In shotgun sports it can mean the winning of an event, a tournament, a round, or a goal achieved. It can also mean something less tangible but as rewarding, such as a well-managed mental game, a goal of X - number of targets or that elusive Personal Best.

Many young ORSA athletes are achieving success by all these definitions. Whether that be in the SCTP league, or the NSCA/ NSSA ranks, ORSA is quickly becoming a recognized avenue for all measures of success for our young athletes as they pursue their individual goals.

Part of this success comes from things like clinics which help athletes of all levels obtain the knowledge of how to improve their game. Skill is obtained when that knowledge is applied over time and effort. Then success comes with time and effort being applied to the skillset.

Another part is the time and facilities that ORSA provides for the athletes and their coaches to practice their chosen crafts. Our facilities are as good as can be found anywhere and the efforts to keep individual costs down are certainly appreciated by the athlete's families.

So, here's a list of recent achievements by our shotgun athletes on the State & National Stages. If we've overlooked any, please forgive us. For space and clarity, we've not included team, squad, or Regional events, as the Rangefinder can only accommodate so much. We also didn't include those who have shot at ORSA from time to time, but aren't members.

Our very own Sporting Clays Master, **Todd Hitch**, has had tremendous success taking home HOA & Jr. Champion from the American Gran Prix. He's also won FITASC at the Gran Prix, and the East Coast Championship. Todd also helped with our Sporting Clays Clinic; giving pointers and showing the younger athletes they could achieve much with hard work.

At the **TNSCTP State Championships** in June, ORSA contributed in many places. In the Rookie (Elementary School) Division, **Cylas Prince** was HOA Champion, followed by **Skyler Beauchene** in 2nd. Cylas swept Skeet, Sporting and Trap taking all 3 Championships went home with him! Skyler was 2nd in skeet, 3rd in Sporting. **Isabella Carr** was Ladies Sporting Champion and took 2nd place in Skeet.

Moving up to the **Intermediate (Middle School) Division**, **Miller Rutter** took 3rd Place in Sporting Clays in Advanced, and **Justin Umbarger** took 3rd in Entry level. Justin was IE Skeet Champion and Denver Minor took 3rd place.

For Junior Varsity, **Ashley Sellers** was a force. She took 2nd place in Sporting, 2nd place in Trap, and 3rd place in Skeet.

In the Varsity division, **Wyatt Freels** ran 100 straight in Skeet, claiming the title of State Champion outright.

In the college division **Kaitlyne Hakes** took 3rd place in Skeet and **Kincaid Gillespie** took 3rd in Sporting Clays.

In July approximately 1900 athletes gathered at the Cardinal Center in Morengo, OH to celebrate and compete in the **SCTP National Team Championships**. Over 5000 individual registrations were entered, meaning most shot in more than one event. For the first time, the shoot also encompassed the International Championships, previously held in Colorado Springs. The Cardinal Center is now the official home of SCTP and their support is absolutely amazing. To move the International Championships

to Ohio, they committed and built 4 International Bunker Fields with Skeet Overlays in 40 days! Thanks so much to the Cardinal Center, Promatic, and the other sponsors for making this happen! A new record of over 220 athletes participated in the International Games.

Top achiever for the International games was **Zachary Maggard** who shot a world class 119 in Skeet to win HOA and make the SCTP International Team (one of 3 selected).

In the traditional disciplines, **Hunter Raley** ran an amazing 200 straight on the skeet field and won a shootoff with another athlete handily to be HOA in American Skeet.

**Isabella Carr** also won in a big way taking home the National Championship in Sporting Clays and Skeet for the Ladies Rookie Division. **Cylas Prince** also made the Rookie HOA list, taking 2nd place, with a 2nd in American Skeet and 4th in Sporting Clays.

**Ashley Sellers** had a 2nd place in Ladies Skeet and 2nd in Double Trap, Junior Varsity.

Obviously, this doesn't take into account the successes of shooting a perfect 25 (there were several), and a coach's favorite of a Personal Best. You cannot ask more of an athlete than to do better than they've ever done, and we saw many of those.

Given the nature of a Student Athlete, we should also mention those who were recognized on the National Stage for their combined shooting and scholastic achievements. Selected this year to the 2020 National All Scholastic Team were: Cylas Prince, Cole Prince, Nicholas Lyons, Will Gardner, Justin Umbarger, Hunter Raley, Wyatt Freels and Zachary Maggard.

In closing, when you run into any of our young athletes, please offer them your congratulations, your support and your thanks for representation of ORSA in such a positive way.

## MEMBERSHIP NEWS

It is time to answer a couple of the most frequently asked questions of the membership secretary:

When it comes time to renew a common question that is asked is: My original sponsor is no longer with the club and/or do I need a sponsor when I renew?? The answer is no – a sponsor is only required of new members the first time they submit their membership application. On the membership form – including the renewal form, you will see a “My Sponsorship Status” section. You only need to fill this out when you apply for your original membership. There is no need to fill it out with your renewal form.

And another frequent question: Is there a renewal fee on Spouse Cards? No – there is no renewal fee on spouse cards. Spouse cards are available for the one-time fee of \$10 each. We do ask that the spouse fill out

and send in the renewal form with any updated/corrected information so we can ensure that the membership info we have is up to date. When initially inquiring about a spouse card we do require that the spouse fill out a membership application as the spouse is given their own badge. We also require that the spouse attend orientation in order to receive the badge. Since they have the opportunity to come to the range on their own they need to be familiar with ORSA range rules.

As always, if you’ve had any changes in your contact information whether it is address, phone or email in between renewals– please let us know so we can be sure you’re receiving the Rangefinder and your renewal notices via snail mail.

## WHAT THE ELECTION PORTENDS

In the 15 years or so that I have been writing this column we have been through a lot of elections. Through all these years I've written about the many threats to our Second Amendment rights. The one thing that has been a constant is that of the two political parties in America, one party has stood out as a threat to these constitutionally guaranteed rights. The other party has made it a consistent part of their policies and platform to support those rights.

Throughout these years we've all known that it was the Democrat Party that opposed our Second Amendment rights. But for many of those election cycles the Democrats knew that if they openly stated their bias against gun rights it would hurt them at the polls. So they mouthed that they "really didn't want to take away our guns" while secretly planning to do such a thing.

- The import, sale, transfer or possession of assault weapons would be banned
- All large capacity magazines (more than 10 rounds) would be banned and it would be a felony if possessed
- Red-flag laws would be a federal law
- Federally licensed gun dealers would have to submit and annually certify compliance with a security plan to detect and deter firearm theft
- Federal standards for gun locks and gun safes
- It would be a felony if a weapon is left unsecured in the home
- Removes limitations on the civil liability of gun manufacturers
- The Consumer Product Safety Commission is in charge of safety standards for firearms and firearm components

Sadly this not some fiction made up by George Orwell. Joe Biden has made it clear that his administration will pursue gun control. All his options for vice president are rabid anti-Second Amendment activists. Biden said that he was going to put former Texas Congressman and presidential candidate Eric Swalwell ("Hell yes we're going to take your AR15's") in charge of his gun control effort. If Joe Biden makes his way to the White House it is a good bet that the Senate will go to the Democrats and the House majority will increase. So is the above list fiction?
