The new gate at the Action Pistol Range is completed and operational. The new gate will control access to the range for practice only but will remain open during Action Pistol matches. Access will be granted to those who meet one of the following requirements:

- Regular participation in AP competition matches (IDPA, USPSA, Cowboys, Steel Challenge, 3GUN, NRL22).
- Attend an AP Orientation. These classes are scheduled on the last Monday of the month. The classes will be held at the AP building.
- There will be two Orientation classes on March 29th. Once registered the applicant will receive a notice that they have been approved to attend the session. Due to limited seating and health restrictions Walk-ins are not allowed.
- Once approved, you will be entered into the AP database and access will be granted using your current ORSA membership card.

Well it didn't take long for the Democrats to start their siege on our Bill of Rights, especially on the right they despise most, the Right to Keep and Bear Arms. The Democrat controlled House of Representatives passed several gun control bills last session but they knew the bills would go nowhere since the Republicans controlled the Senate and the White House. Now that the Democrats control the House, Senate, and the White House, they are emboldened and out in the open for their disdain of our rights guaranteed by the Second Amendment.

H.R. 127 is their flagship piece of legislation and is highlighted below. It scares me and should scare you. However there is hope. This bill would still have to pass the whole House and Senate. There are a lot of Democrats House and Senate members that are from districts or states where the citizens they represent are avid supporters of the Second Amendment. I must believe that this bill would never get to Biden's desk, where if it ever did he would sign with relish.

Yet to be seen is what Biden would do via executive orders. He is already ruling by executive orders with more than the 40 he has already issued. His VP, Harris, loudly proclaimed during her brief run for the presidency that she would give Congress 100 days to pass gun control legislation or she would start issuing executive orders. We still must stay alert to what this administration is doing and the threats to our rights.

H.R. 127 "SABIKA SHEIKH FIREARM LICENSING AND REGISTRATION ACT"

Rep. Sheila Jackson Lee (D-TX) has wasted no time taking advantage that the Democrats control the House,

Senate, and the White House. This bill is "To provide for the licensing of firearm and ammunition possession and the registration of firearms, and to prohibit the possession of certain ammunition." Introduced on January 4, 2021. I've selected some of the major aspects of this legislation below:

- The Attorney General, through the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, shall establish a system for licensing the possession of firearms or ammunition in the United States, and for the registration with the Bureau of each firearm present in the United States.
- **FIREARM REGISTRATION SYSTEM.—**
- "(1) REQUIRED INFORMATION.—Under the firearm registration system, the owner of a firearm shall transmit to the Bureau—
- "(A) the make, model, and serial number of the firearm, the identity of the owner of the firearm, the date the firearm was acquired by the owner, and where the firearm is or will be stored; and
- "(B) a notice specifying the identity of any person to whom, and any period of time during which, the firearm will be loaned to the person.
- "(2) DEADLINE FOR SUPPLYING INFORMATION.—The transmission required by paragraph (1) shall be made—

- “(A) in the case of a firearm acquired before the effective date of this section, within 3 months after the effective date of this section; or
- “(B) in the case of a firearm acquired on or after the effective date, on the date the owner acquires the firearm.
- **“(3) DATABASE.—**
- “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Attorney General shall establish and maintain a database of all firearms registered pursuant to this subsection.
- “(B) ACCESS.—The Attorney General shall make the contents of the database accessible to all members of the public, all Federal, State, and local law enforcement authorities, all branches of the United States Armed Forces, and all State and local governments, as defined by the Bureau.
- Licensing system.—
- **“(1) REQUIREMENTS.—**
- “(A) GENERAL LICENSE.—Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the Attorney General shall issue to an individual a license to possess a firearm and ammunition if the individual—
 - “(i) has attained 21 years of age;
 - “(ii) after applying for the license—
 - “(l) undergoes a criminal background check conducted by the national instant criminal background check system established under section 103 of the Brady Handgun Violence Prevention Act, and the check does not indicate that possession of a firearm by the individual would violate subsection (g) or (n) of section 922 or State law;
 - “(ll) undergoes a psychological evaluation conducted in accordance with paragraph (2), and the evaluation does not indicate that the individual is psychologically unsuited to possess a firearm; and
 - “(lll) successfully completes a training course,
- certified by the Attorney General, in the use, safety, and storage of firearms, that includes at least 24 hours of training; and
- “(iii) demonstrates that, on issuance of the license, the individual will have in effect an insurance policy issued under subsection (d).
- **MILITARY-STYLE WEAPONS LICENSE.—**The Attorney General shall issue to an individual a license to own and possess a military-style weapon if the individual—
 - “(i) is the holder of a license issued under subparagraph (A); and
 - “(ii) after applying for a license under this subparagraph, successfully completes a training course, certified by the Attorney General, in the use, safety, and storage of the weapon, that includes at least 24 hours of training and live fire training.
- **PSYCHOLOGICAL EVALUATION.—**A psychological evaluation is conducted in accordance with this paragraph if—
 - “(A) the evaluation is conducted in compliance with such standards as shall be established by the Attorney General;
 - “(B) the evaluation is conducted by a licensed psychologist approved by the Attorney General;
 - “(C) as deemed necessary by the licensed psychologist involved, the evaluation included a psychological evaluation of other members of the household in which the individual resides; and
 - “(D) as part of the psychological evaluation, **the licensed psychologist interviewed any spouse of the individual, any former spouse of the individual, and at least 2 other persons who are a member of the family of, or an associate of, the individual to further determine the state of the mental, emotional, and relational stability of the individual in relation to firearms.** (my emphasis)
- It shall be unlawful for a person to transfer a firearm

or ammunition to a person who is not licensed under section 932(c)(1).

- “It shall be unlawful for a person to sell or give a firearm or ammunition to another person unless the person has notified the Attorney General of the sale or gift.
- PENALTIES.—Section 924(a) of such title is amended by adding at the end the following:
 - “(8) Whoever knowingly violates section 922(aa) shall be fined not less than \$75,000 and not more than \$150,000, imprisoned not less than 15 years and not more than 25 years, or both.
- It shall be unlawful for any person to possess a large capacity ammunition feeding device.
- The term ‘large capacity ammunition feeding device’ means a magazine, belt, drum, feed strip, or similar device that has a capacity of, or that can be readily restored or converted to accept, more than 10 rounds of ammunition, but does not include an attached tubular device designed to accept, and capable of operating only with, .22 caliber rimfire ammunition.”.
- Whoever knowingly violates section 922(dd)(2) (just above) shall be fined not less than \$10,000 and not more than \$25,000, imprisoned not less than 1 year and not more than 5 years, or both.”

Now that is an infringement of the Second Amendment!!

So what can you and I do to make sure this abomination never gets to Biden’s desk? The first thing is to make sure our senators and representatives stay strong and never waiver in their support of the Second Amendment. There will be tremendous pressure from all quarters “to do something about all this gun violence.” The Democrats own the media and you can bet every so-called news channel or publication will be all-in supporting this law. “We have to do this for the children doncha know” and “we have to stop to carnage on the streets doncha know” and “doncha care about the thousands of people killed

by weapons of war every day, every second.” We have to let our representatives to this government that they must represent Tennesseans who oppose any restrictions to the Second Amendment.

I think the next approach we should take is contacting our legislators in Nashville. In my mind it is the duty of our state legislators and governor to protect Tennesseans from the abuses of and infringements on the freedoms and liberties guaranteed by the Constitution. They must pass laws protecting every aspect of the Second Amendment, even if TN laws are counter to federal laws. Now, this will take some guts by our legislators and governor. It is our duty to contact them and let them know that they must act to protect us from the Constitutional abuses by the federal government.

This is from the TN Firearms Association:

We believe that one reason that some in the Legislature have these issues on their minds is that TFA members and supporters are active, informed and engaged. TFA cannot understate the significance of this. For Tennessee’s conservatives and gun owners to succeed legislatively in 2021, it is going to be important for the following to occur:

- TFA members and supporters need to understand who their individual legislators are. You can look that information up on the state’s lookup tool (<https://app.getresponse.com/click.html?x=a62b&lc=Ba3RKO&mc=JA&s=zwPcQe&u=izZc&z=EVkJfx&>)

- if you do not already know. Make sure you have the names of your legislators, their office and home numbers are on your notepad or phone, and that you have their mailing address (real letters are better) stored.

- TFA members and supporters need to devote enough time each week to call their legislators and ask to speak directly with them - not just staff. Ask for call backs if you have to. Call after hours if you need to and leave vote messages. Make sure you are making direct contact at least once a week. What do you need to tell them? A few things at a minimum. Your name, that you are a constituent and give an address, that you are a “Tennessee Firearms Association” supporter, that you are calling to support specific bill numbers and issues (e.g., HB25 on civil immunity protections) and that you want to know if they (your legislators) support it, are they co-sponsoring it and if not why not, and what other legislators are they talking to - particularly committee members - to make sure it passes.

- If you can’t reach them or they don’t return your calls, write a letter each week and send it to your House

and Senate members. Send a real letter. Don't email it. Don't fax it. Put a stamp on it and mail it. It makes a real difference in an era when our domestic enemies are trying to flood legislators with email campaigns.

- Make time to go see them face to face. Even if you can't get to Nashville during the week to see them at the Legislative offices, you can make time to see them at their homes, churches, restaurants, and jobs on the days they are not in Nashville. Go see them. Tell them the things you would tell them on the phone. Make sure they know you are interested and focused on these issues. Make sure they know that you expect them to vote for these bills, push these bills forward and override a veto if necessary.

Tennessee Firearms Association is a grassroots advocacy group. It's success comes from informed, active members who have personal relationships with their legislators. Its success also comes from supporting and helping to educate individuals who want to be elected officials at local and state level opportunities. The TFA's
