## ORSA SKEET, TRAP, AND SPORTING CLAYS ADAPTIVE SHOOTING FOR MEMBERS WITH DISABILITIES



According to the most current census data, there are approximately 74 million individuals that identify as disabled. This population is growing as the Baby Boomer generation ages and as injured soldiers have returned from overseas. As a group, they are generally under-represented in shooting sports. ORSA Skeet, Trap, and Sporting Clays has been working to solve that problem for our members and guests. We want to provide participation in shooting activities for people with disabilities that are fun and safe.

Sporting Clays has recently added four Adaptive Shooting stations for members with disabilities on our 13-station course. These stations were designed and built by ORSA members volunteers. Construction was led by Lou



Berretta, with help from Jose Rivera, Steve Carroll, Ron Tyre, Bob Romano, and Todd Kissling. Jeff Weinrich worked on the drawing for the original plans. According to Lou Berretta, "it was a team effort."

The stations made of treated lumber, sit on large concrete slabs which allows easy access by wheelchair for the Adaptive Shooter.



Adaptive Shooter Dennis Clark tried out the new station and commented "it was great fun and thanks to ORSA for providing shooters like me a place to go."

## MEMBERSHIP DUES INCREASE

As everyone knows the cost of everything is increasing. We are lucky here at ORSA that so much of our work is done by you - the members of ORSA. We rely on our volunteers to do painting, trim trees, be range officers, run matches and a host of other duties. When you read the rangefinder you often see articles thanking these volunteers for their time and effort. We need and appreciate you!

We do however pay to have the grass mowed, utilities, paving, porta-potties and yes our favorite taxes to name just a few. The Second Amendment isn't about "technology", and it isn't even about guns...it's about a principle: The right and ability to overthrow a tyrannical government, if necessary. That principle is as legitimate today as it was in 1791.

Guns, as they are to anyone who understands this hands-on right, are the tools of freedom. They are the mechanical instruments we need to be proficient with in a dangerous world. Like other tools, they can be used for good or bad. As they can be used for good or bad, taking guns away from a free people, weakens or even destroys all of our rights, making good citizens vulnerable to the worst among us.

Not trusting "we the people" with our Second amendment rights means that a person doesn't believe that this democratic republic can work and so must be transformed into something else, as Joe Biden is now trying to do. What has Joe Biden SAID he would do?

- Bring back the 1994 Clinton Gun Ban that expired in 2004
- End the online sale of firearms, ammunition, kits, and gun parts
- Push states (and bribe them with federal \$) to require you to get a license prior to purchasing guns and ammunition
- Limit the number of firearms you can purchase to one per month
- Put America on the path to requiring 100% of firearms sold to have "smart" technology
- Hold adults criminally responsible for allowing a minor access to a firearm
- Institute gun registration via "enhanced background checks"



- Repeal the Protection of Lawful Commerce in 'arms Act (PLCAA) which would open the door for frivolous lawsuits of gun and ammunition manufacturers thus bankrupting them.

Biden's gun control agenda would be the end of the Second Amendment as we know it. Biden and his ilk simply don't trust the individual American with the rights enumerated in the U.S. Constitution's Bill of Rights.

The Second Amendment protects "the right of the people to keep and bear arms," and in the majority decision in District of Columbia v. Heller overwhelmingly showed that, as written by our Founders, the Second Amendment could only be correctly understood to protect individual rights. The Court continued to strengthen the Second Amendment through the 2010 decision in McDonald v. City of Chicago. The plaintiff in McDonald challenged the constitutionality of the Chicago handgun ban, which prohibited handgun possession by al-

most all private citizens. In a 5-4 decisions, the Court, citing the intentions of the framers and ratifiers of the Fourteenth Amendment, held that the Second Amendment applies to the states through the incorporation doctrine.

So settled law, right? The Ninth Circuit Court recently determined that: "There is no right to carry arms openly in public; nor is any such right within the scope of the Second Amendment." A few years before the Ninth Circuit ruled that; "There is no Second Amendment right for members of the general public to carry concealed firearms in public."

In the eleven years since those two Second Amendment landmark cases, the Supreme Court has denied hearing

at least ten cases that have been brought to the court of further clarify Second Amendment law. Associate Justice Clarence Thomas has lamented that the Second Amendment has been treated as a “disfavored right.”

You must believe that we citizens, who believe in the Second Amendment, are in a fight for our freedom and liberty. And fight is not too strong a word. We have the White House aligned against us. We have the whole of the federal bureaucracy aligned against us. We have a majority of the U.S. Congress aligned against us. We have the whole of the legacy media in this country aligned against us. We cannot be the “silent majority” anymore. We must make our beliefs, voices and opinions heard. We also have to be educated about our Second Amendment rights and the threats to those rights. We should be able (and willing) to debate a neighbor, relative, or friend who is anti-gun rights and then convince them of the error of their ways. We must let our local, state, and congressional legislators know how we feel and that we are watching them. We must DEMAND of them to protect our freedoms and liberty.

#### **WHITE HOUSE PULLS ANTI-GUN ATF NOMINEE**

Joe Biden’s attempt to put a fox into the hen house of Americans’ Second Amendment rights was stopped by Thomas Gallatin

Joe Biden’s attempt to sneak in an anti-gun lobbyist to head the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives has failed, as the White House announced it is pulling the nomination of David Chipman.

Of course, the Biden administration sought to pin the blame entirely on Republicans, stating:

Unfortunately, Republicans in Congress have made clear that they intend to use gun crime as a political talking point instead of taking serious steps to address it. That’s why they’ve moved in lockstep to block David Chipman’s confirmation, and it’s why they side with gun manufacturers over the overwhelming majority of the American people in opposing commonsense measures like universal background checks.

However, the fact of the matter is that the White House pulled Chipman because several Democrat lawmakers weren’t on board, and for several reasons beyond his anti-gun views.

For one thing, Chipman was exposed for being an anti-firearm lobbyist who had no interest in protecting Americans’ Second Amendment rights, even mocking people for purchasing their first firearms during the pandemic lockdown. Not only that, but it also came to light that he holds negative views regarding Americans’ First Amendment rights to free of speech.

In 2019 Chipman groused: “The frustration is, in the United States, the freedom of speech and to say things is largely — cannot be regulated. We have to do more to monitor hate speech on the Internet. But we also have to do more to curb that same speech being presented by our

president and other elected public officials.”

Chipman further asserted, “The FBI [and] other federal agencies have a tough job responding to these threats when they don’t currently have the authority to remove weaponry just because people are saying hateful things.” That comment is a red flag about red flag laws.

It was also discovered that Chipman had deleted thousands of past social media posts and failed to disclose several previous interviews and activities. And what may have been the final nail in the coffin was a whistleblower report alleging that Chipman “has exhibited a pattern of extremely concerning racially biased behavior” during his time at the ATF. That includes reports of Chipman filing a DOJ complaint that Senator Chuck Grassley says triggered “an unwarranted investigation into an African American employee who he alleged, without evidence, cheated on an exam to become a GS-15.”

Senator Tom Cotton aptly responded to the White House’s announcement: “David Chipman is an unhinged gun-grabber. His defeat is a win for the Constitution — and a crushing loss for Joe Biden.” It’s not as if anyone Biden nominates will be a defender of gun rights, but, for now, Liberty-loving Americans dodged this Second Amendment-threatening bullet.

#### **CHIPMAN JUST LATEST IN GUN CONTROL DEFEATS FOR BIDEN**

President Joe Biden ran as one of the most anti-Second Amendment candidates in history. Sure, there were others in the race who focused on gun control, but Biden pretty much agreed with them on the issue and he made it through to the general election. It was clearly on the agenda.

With most of the year behind us, Biden is reeling from having to withdraw the nomination of David Chipman, but that’s far from the only anti-Second Amendment move he’s made that’s seeming gone down in flames.

President Biden’s decision to pull David Chipman as his nominee to run the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) is a high-profile victory for pro-gun groups and a defeat for gun control advocates in what will likely be this year’s most consequential gun debate.

The withdrawal shows that even under Democratic control of Congress and the White House, efforts to tighten restrictions on guns face an uphill climb.

Chipman’s nomination fell not just because of opposition from Republicans, but also moderate Democrats.

Biden pulled Chipman’s nomination after Sen. Angus King (I-Maine), who caucuses with Democrats, privately said he wouldn’t support him. Democrats had no room for defections in the 50-50 Senate, and Sens. Jon Tester (D-Mont.) and Joe Manchin (D-W.Va.) also declined to endorse Chipman.

It's just the latest defeat for gun control advocates.

Senate Democrats earlier this year failed to round up enough votes for a House-passed bill to expand background checks on gun sales, leaving gun control advocates with little to look forward to this Congress.

White House press secretary Jen Psaki said Thursday that Biden will announce a new ATF nominee "at an appropriate time."

But gun control groups reacting to Chipman's withdrawal weren't hiding their disappointment.

"The Senate had the opportunity to confirm a supremely qualified and dedicated public servant as ATF director. Instead, the gun lobby's campaign of baseless conspiracy theories and outright lies succeeded in blocking him," Giffords Executive Director Peter Ambler said in a statement.

First, Chipman wasn't "supremely qualified." He lacked significant leadership experience during his time at the ATF, for example. What Ambler meant to say was that Chipman had the right opinions for him.

As for "conspiracy theories and outright lies," they're referring to a number of allegations, including some that suggested Chipman made racially insensitive remarks about black agents at the ATF. These were supposedly investigated at the time, but since his personnel record was never released to Congress—something that, in theory, should have cleared all this up if the allegations were false—we're left to wonder.

Of course, the fact that Chipman didn't ask for those records to be released to Congress after the allegations surfaced tells us that there was likely something in there he didn't want to get out. Since Stephen Gutowski over at The Reload had multiple sources saying as much, I have no reason to doubt the allegations as they stand.

But, as noted, that's just the latest setback for the gun control crowd. This despite ultimately having an effective majority in both chambers of Congress and the White House.

For some, this is a sign that our system is broken, but people forget that our Founding Fathers were distrustful of government and for good reason. They wanted to make it fairly difficult for laws to be created as a way to try and prevent tyranny from taking hold. Little did they know that a couple of hundred years later, people would be screaming for it.

This is where we are now, but thankfully there are mechanisms in place that keep Democrats in Congress from running completely roughshod over our rights.

## **ATTITUDES SHIFT TOWARD RIGHTS OVER CONTROL AS GUN OWNERSHIP GROWS**

There's an interesting shift concerning Americans' attitudes toward guns and gun control. Pew Research Center, a Washington, D.C. think tank that tracks attitudes on social issues, public opinion, and demographic trends updated their research on guns.

Gun ownership is rising and the appetite for gun control is waning at the same time. Background checks for gun sales topped 21 million in 2020, shattering previous records. So far, 2021 has seen over 12.4 million background checks, on pace for what could be the second strongest year on record.

### **GUN OWNERSHIP GROWING**

Those figures are punctuated by skyrocketing numbers of first-time gun buyers. NSSF retailer surveys last year indicated that as much as 40 percent of gun sales went to those purchasing their first firearm, or 8.4 million in 2020. Another survey released just last week by NSSF delved into gun sales in 2021, and as much as 33.2 percent, or 3.2 million people, bought a gun for the very first time in the first six months of 2021.

Even Pew Research Center recognized the trends. Pew's latest gun surveys show firearm ownership is remaining steady with 40 percent of American households reporting a firearm in the home, including 30 percent who reported personally owning a firearm. Still, there's reason to be cautious of these anonymous surveys.

NSSF reports there are at least 434 million firearms in circulation. NSSF reports there are over 20 million Modern Sporting Rifles (MSRs), or AR-15 style rifles, are in circulation. They are the most popular selling centerfire rifle in America today.

Pew's findings of the reasons for gun ownership match what NSSF uncovered. Most people are buying guns for personal protection. NSSF found the same results in the 2020 retail surveys. More than half the firearms sold in any typical year are handguns and that held true during the record-breaking 2020 buying surge.

As Americans are taking ownership of their Second Amendment rights, the appetite for stricter gun control is fading. Pew Research Center referenced an April survey that showed 53 percent of those surveyed wanted stricter gun controls. Pew also reported that 48 percent of Americans viewed "gun violence" as a very big problem, which also underscores why record numbers of Americans are buying firearms for protection.

These attitudes are more commonly shared today. Gun ownership is growing and Americans are increasingly demanding laws that protect their rights and hold criminals responsible.
