ATTENTION BLACK POWDER ENTHUSIASTS

Based on your responses and discussion here is what I've come up with to get us started.

WHERE: ORSA Range

WHEN: Starting with the first Thursday in April – April 7 at 4:00 PM and continuing each month on the first Thursday of the month.

WHO: Open to all black powder firearms – flint lock, cap lock, in-line, and pistol

REQUIREMENT: it must use black powder or it's equivalent.

We'll shoot various targets at different distances. Some will be traditional black powder targets (from NMLRA) along with assorted fun things. Targets will be furnished and included for a modest fee.

We will be on the competition pistol range next to benchrest and across from the indoor range.

CIVILIAN MARKSMANSHIP PROGRAM (CMP) HIGHPOWER RIFLE CLINIC **APRIL 16 & SEPTEMBER 24, 2022, 8:00 AM - ORSA ED T. JOHNSON INDOOR RANGE FACILITY**

We will meet at ORSA's Ed T. Johnson Indoor Range Facility on April 16, 2022, and September 24, 2022. Attendance at a basic rifle clinic is required before attending a highpower rifle clinic, or prior marksmanship training and evidence of prior competitive experience.

ORSA will provide your choice of an AR-15 or M1 Garand, with ammo. With prior coordination, you may request to bring your own US Service Rifle (AR-15, M1-Garand, or M-1A and ammo) provided it meets current CMP rules. If you are permitted to bring your gear, cost is \$10.00. If you are using an ORSA rifle, ammo, and equipment; cost is \$40.00 for use of AR, \$60 for the use of M1 Garand.

If you wish to participate, please read, and follow the instructions below.

- RSVP to David Kiefer orsaclinic@gmail.com, answer the following questions:
- What is your name, email address, and age?
- Are you furnishing your own rifle and ammo? If you are, provide details to ensure CMP compliance. (just google CMP Highpower Rules)
- Or, Will you need a club AR-15 (or M1)? (note, only club ammo may be fired in club rifles)
- Are you left-handed?
- You will then get a confirmation email which will have additional information.

Once have received your conformation email you must notify us before Wednesday before the clinic if you cannot attend so others may take your spot. If you do not provide a cancelation notice, your participation in future clinics will not be guaranteed.

THE DAY OF THE CLASS:

- Schedule: Report to the ORSA Ed T. Johnson Indoor Range Facility at 8:00 AM Saturday.
- Firing will be complete by 4:00 PM.
- You will register, receive an introductory course of instruction and will be assigned a shooting relay and target number before being released to the high power range
- All firing (45 shots) will be conducted from the 200 Yard Line.
- Upon reporting to the firing line, you will be paired with a coach and fitted with a shooting jacket and glove.
- Upon reporting to the pits, you will learn target scoring procedures.

FEES (Cash or check made out to ORSA):

- \$40.00 (\$60 for M1) for club rifle, ammo, and equipment
- \$10.00 if participant brings their own rifle, equipment and ammo

RANGE REQUIREMENTS, SAFETY, AND COMFORT:

- Space is limited,
- Eye and Ear Protection are required on all ORSA ranges and must be furnished by participants.
- Dress for the weather predicted, to include a hat and sunscreen. An inclement weather plan exists in the event of rain.
- No Muzzle Brakes, shooters and coaches are near each other on the firing line.
- Bring plenty to drink, and a light lunch.

This month we will look at three things that are very troubling for our Republic. The first is the resurgence of the UN Small Arms treaty with its gun control at the global level. Second Amendment supporters have always been concerned about a gun registry maintained by the government. Well the UN treaty mandates a gun registry and recently it has been discovered that the ATF has indeed been creating a de-facto gun registry, illegally. Further the Biden

Administration has declared via a Homeland Security Threat Advisory that the biggest threat to the U.S. is those who oppose vaccine mandates and are critical of the government as domestic terrorists. Our Constitution and Bill of Rights is under direct attack.

anything from semi-auto rifles to shotguns and handguns;

*** Restrictions on the number of guns and amount of ammo any "properly-licensed" individual may legally own;

*** Bans on magazines holding more than ten rounds; and

*** Bans on owning a firearm for self-defense -- unless a citizen can somehow demonstrate need and get federal government approval.

To those who think government holds all the answers, Americans' Second Amendment freedoms are a threat to their grand "utopian" designs for all of us.

ATF ADMITS IT HAS NEARLY 1 BILLION GUN RECORDS, GOP LAWMAKERS ASK, 'HOW IS THIS NOT A REGISTRY?'

Is the ATF planning a gun registry?

The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives is in hot water (again) after one of its officials admitted that the agency currently holds nearly one billion records of gun purchases and that 94% of those records have been digitized.

"In total, ATF manages 920,664,765 OBR as of November 2021. This includes digital and an estimated number of hard copy records that are awaiting image conversion. It is currently estimated that 865,787,086 of those records are in digitalized format," Assistant Director of Public and Government Affairs Daniel L. Board, Jr. said in a letter to Congress.

The controversy began after 52 members of Congress sent a letter to the ATF demanding that the agency justify a new rule that would prohibit FFLs from destroying gun purchase records after 20 years. Current law allows gun dealers to destroy records older than 20 years.

Since the ATF requires FFLs that go out of business to transfer all records to their facility in West Virginia, prohibiting those



dealers from destroying records would, eventually, give the ATF a registry of all gun purchases made throughout the country.

“We are concerned that this Administration is leveraging its power in a way to establish a federal gun registry,” the congress-people said in a letter back in November 2021. Such a registry would be illegal under federal law.

Board claimed in his response that the ATF’s “Out of Business Records Imaging System” does not “capture and store certain key information, such as firearms purchaser information, in an automated file.” But Board also tries to justify the system by pointing out that the records are used by law enforcement to trace “crime guns.” It’s unclear how those traces are useful if purchaser information is not captured.

GOVERNMENT’S ATTACK ON CITIZEN MILITIAS IS AN OBLIQUE ATTACK ON THE 2ND AMENDMENT

“In 1998, Americans were exposed to the specter of martial law in the form of a hit movie, ‘The Siege.’ The movie vividly depicted the aftermath of a terrorist attack on New York City where the government declared martial law and rounded up thousands of Arab-Americans and put them in internment camps. Unfortunately, some time in the future, life may imitate art and America’s experience with martial law may extend outside the movie theater into reality. It seems obvious that a number of anti-American groups exist both within and without our borders that would not hesitate to employ terrorism and other tactics that could result in upheaval and, perhaps, anarchy within our country.

The circumstances that would prompt a declaration of mar-

tial law are so horrendous that they are almost beyond contemplation. But that dreadful eventuality should not translate into a lack of preparation, for if the nation is prepared, it is less likely to fear even the most awful possibilities. Those who worry about the profound legal, moral and social implications of declaring martial law must seriously contemplate Thomas Jefferson’s insightful words:

‘A strict observance of the written laws is doubtless one of the high duties of a good citizen, but it is not the highest. The laws of necessity, of self-preservation, of saving our country when in danger, are of higher obligation. To lose our country by a scrupulous adherence to written law, would be to lose the law itself, with life, liberty, property and all those who are enjoying them with us; thus absurdly sacrificing the end to the means . . . The officer who is called to act on this superior ground, does indeed risk himself on the justice of the controlling powers of the Consti-

tution, and his station makes it his duty to incur that risk . . . The line of discrimination between cases may be difficult; but the good officer is bound to draw it at his own peril, and throw himself on the justice of his country and the rectitude of his motives.’” “The Imposition of Martial Law In The United States,” 49 A.F. L. Rev. 67, (2000), by Major Kirk L.

Davies, Chief of Operations Law in the Office of the Staff Judge Advocate, 16th Air Force, Aviano AB, Italy.

Necessity and Self-Preservation inform Thomas Jefferson’s consideration that, perhaps, the U.S. Constitution might, in theory, one day, need be suspended if the threat to the continued existence of the Country as a free Constitutional Republic were sufficiently severe.

On this score, Jefferson is absolutely, catastrophically wrong! If the Government IS the Tyrant, it has no lawful basis for existence.

Under no circumstances is suspension of the Constitution ever warranted. For that would mean, suspension of the Bill of Rights—It is anathema because it is the sovereign authority of the people in whom the Country as a free Constitutional Republic exists. Suspension of the Constitution/Bill of Rights IS tantamount to self-immolation—Suicide! (my emphasis)

Suspension of the Nation’s Bill of Rights is tantamount to the destruction of the very Republic that Thomas Jefferson, as cited by the author of the afore-referenced article, seems to talk about preserving. To suggest that a circumstance could arise where the Bill of Rights—including, then, the Second Amendment—can justifiably, rationally, legally, be suspended as a necessary step in securing the Republic is a contradiction in terms.

The Armed Is The Republic. Destroy the Armed Citizenry is equivalent to Destruction of the Republic. (my emphasis)

The dire situation facing the Nation today springs from a Government operating contra to the Constitution—a renegade

beast—existing for no purpose other than to destroy a free Republic, i.e., to destroy a sovereign American people. Tyranny of Government = Treason By Government.

The American people have no duty to suffer a Government whose very existence is directed to the destruction of a free Constitutional Republic, ergo destruction of the sovereignty of the American people over Government. And in that regard and given the fact that the very presence of this imposter—a senile, corrupt, flaccid, incompetent placeholder of a hidden ruthless force—occupying the Executive Branch of Government, as Chief Executive, is the face of an immense, elaborate and diabolical fraud perpetrated on the American people, the American people have a right and the concomitant responsibility to voice vociferous objection to the inanity observed.

But no armed resistance should be effectuated against this Harris-Biden Administration until or unless the Administration itself initiates action against the American people.

See the article titled, "Gun Control and the American Revolution," by the Second Amendment scholar, David Kopel, published on the website, Guns&Tactics.

The article commences, thus—

"This Article reviews the British gun control program that precipitated the American Revolution: the 1774 import ban on firearms and gunpowder; the 1774-75 confiscations of firearms and gunpowder; and the use of violence to effectuate the confiscations. It was these events that changed a situation of political tension into a shooting war. Each of these British abuses provides insights into the scope of the modern Second Amendment.

Furious at the December 1773 Boston Tea Party, Parliament in 1774 passed the Coercive Acts. The particular provisions of the Coercive Acts were offensive to Americans, but it was the possibility that the British might deploy the army to enforce them

that primed many colonists for armed resistance. The Patriots of Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, resolved: 'That in the event of Great Britain attempting to force unjust laws upon us by the strength of arms, our cause we leave to heaven and our rifles.' A South Carolina newspaper essay, reprinted in Virginia, urged that any law that had to be enforced by the military was necessarily illegitimate."

The insidious thing about present-day events is that the shadowy forces that seek to destroy this Nation and, hence, the sovereignty of the American people, have deviously, surreptitiously attacked the Nation and its people and the Nation's Constitution from within.

They have employed corrupt treacherous instruments of tyranny to betray the Nation. Under the pretense of serving the Country and its people by the very fact of being Office-holders,

these characters have been betraying the Country and its people, implementing policies, prepared for them by outside, powerful, ruthless elements.

All of these policies are aimed at destroying the Country. Some of these policies can be seen in U.N. compacts and position papers that Congress has never signed onto, such as the Open
