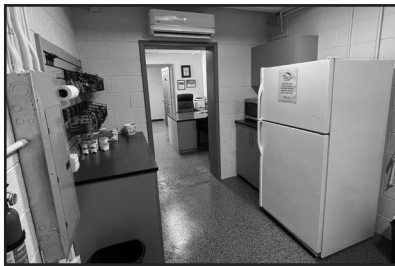

ARCHERY CHANGES VOL 2

In last month's Range Finder, I went over some major changes in the Archery Range usages.

This article is to further clarify the changes being made, effective May 31, 2022. We will no longer allow crossbows and broadheads to be used on the current block range. It has always been against the rules to shoot 3D targets with either one, but the condition of targets shows that broadheads are being used on both 3D and block targets. Their continual use on the block targets destroys the block.

A new range will be constructed behind the Indoor Range. Until this range is completed, the use of all crossbows, broadheads, and practice type arrows which are expandable will be suspended.

We will build a new range behind the Ed Johnson Indoor Range building. New signs will be installed when the range set-up is completed. We will set two of the large rubber blocks with the store type blocks for broadhead use on this new range. The large blocks will only be used to stop misses. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES ARE THEY TO BE USED AS A PRIMARY TARGET.** We will purchase the block style targets for use this year. If they are shot up quickly, this year will be the last year that the ORSA will provide broadhead targets.

When parking at the Indoor Range, please park to the right of the entrance to the Indoor Range. Leave the parking lot for Indoor Range usage.

Signs will be placed on the back side of the Indoor Range building warning that the new Archery Range could be active.

SAFETY IS ALWAYS THE FIRST CONCERN!

We will install new cameras to help control activity on all Archery Ranges. All individuals utilizing the Archery Range are forewarned that violators of the rules will be brought before the ORSA Board for possible penalties up to and including loss of club membership.

The same Archery Range rules will apply on the new range. Please be aware if you are shooting on the new Broadhead Archery Range that people could step out on either side of the Indoor Range building. Warning signs will be placed on both sides of the Indoor Range building to prevent people from stepping behind the building but Archery shooters must be vigilant.

SAFETY IS ALWAYS THE FIRST CONCERN!

When the new BroadHead Range is open signs will be posted announcing its opening.

The use of Crossbows and BroadHead arrows on the Archery Range will cease on May 31, 2022, until this new range is open. This action is necessary to prevent repeated target damage to ever more expensive targets that are paid for by all ORSA members.

ATTENTION BLACK POWDER ENTHUSIASTS

WHERE: ORSA Range

WHO: Open to all black powder firearms - flint lock, cap lock, in-line, and pistol

REQUIREMENT: It must use black powder or its equivalent.

We will be on the competition pistol range next to benchrest and across from the indoor range.

IN THEIR OWN WORDS

"No amendment is absolute" Joe Biden, said many times when talking about the Second Amendment

On-line sites and social media are banning involvement and comments that some invisible force is denying any comments not "approved." The White House and Democrats in Congress are asking and even demanding that there should be more on-line censorship.

What does this have to do with the Right to Keep and Bear Arms? You and I believe in the Constitution and the Bill of Rights. We are especially advocates of the Second Amendment. Therefore we believe that this right is a god-given right only codified in the Second Amendment. We believe in the right of self-defense, of our family, ourselves, and fellow citizens who are threatened with imminent death or bodily harm.

If we are publically vocal about these rights the Disinforma-

tion Governance Board could deem us as espousing disinformation, a national security threat, and then Homeland Security officers show up at our homes, arrest us, detain us, and confiscate our weapons. Far fetched? I don't think so.

I see the Disinformation Governance Board decreeing that "assault" weapons must be banned; "weapons of war" must be banned and taken from the people; guns are responsible for the crime wave sweeping our country; "gun crimes" can only be stopped by the elimination of guns; "ghost guns" are a threat to national security; and the Second Amendment must be eliminated. These are the truths. Conform and obey. And from Orwell's 1984 - Put people in jail who deny "the truth."

We need to contact our state and national legislators and voice our opposition to this tyrannical government abomination. It should be defunded and disbanded.

THE SECOND AMENDMENT RIGHT TO KEEP AND BEAR ARMS EMBRACES A PROPERTY INTEREST IN FIREARMS

The Second Amendment is the cornerstone of America's rights and liberties. This, we know. But, tucked away in the Second Amendment right to keep and bear arms is another right. It is the right to own property. Its place in and impact on the Second Amendment are rarely, if ever, mentioned.

State laws that deny your right to keep and bear arms also deny your ownership right and interest in your firearms. Let's look at a couple of examples.

Many States utilize licensing schemes to control and restrict civilian access to firearms. Government licensing of firearms is incompatible with the right to keep and bear arms because licensing of firearms is a condition precedent to possession. That means a license to keep and bear arms is nothing more than a privilege to keep and bear arms since possession of firearms is contingent on the government's willingness to grant a license at all. The right is forsaken through licensing. But more is lost.

Once a government revokes the license to possess firearms, as it can since it granted the license in the first place, the owner loses his property. You may have spent thousands of dollars on your firearms. No matter. Your dollar investment is forfeited, along with your firearms. So, a government's abrogation of the Second Amendment guarantee entails the denigration of your private property right and interest in your firearms. If you lose your license, you lose your firearms. Two basic rights are lost, then, not one. The two go hand in-hand.

States that utilize firearms licensing schemes employ firearms' transfer schemes too. Suppose you, as a law-abiding cit-

izen, lawfully acquired your firearms: through bequest, gift, or commercial transaction. The firearms belong to you. You have full and complete title to and control over them, and exclusive and absolute right in them. That's what it means to have a private property interest in your firearms.

Now, suppose you wish to bequeath your firearms to your son, or daughter. Laws that interfere with your ability to transfer your firearms as you wish inhibit your enjoyment of them because you are unable to exercise complete dominion over them. This amounts to an unconstitutional taking of them without due process.

So, the right to keep and bear arms and the right to acquire, own, and hold them perpetually, or transfer them, operate in tandem. Moreover, they are both natural rights.

The Second Amendment merely codifies a preexisting right. Since government cannot rationally bestow a right that already exists within you, government cannot lawfully take that right from you.

The preexisting right to acquire, own, and hold property isn't codified in the Second Amendment, but it is codified in the Due Process Clause and in the Takings Clause of the Fifth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution.

The Fifth Amendment says in critical part: "No person shall be . . . deprived of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law; nor shall private property be taken for public use, without just compensation." The private property interest is, arguably, also one of the unenumerated rights of the catchall Ninth Amendment. It is intrinsic to the Fourth Amendment and it even implicates the Third Amendment, as well as the Second Amendment.

The Due Process Clause and Takings Clause of the Fifth Amendment operate as constraints on the federal government. The Due Process Clause of the Fifth Amendment is mirrored in the Due Process Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment and applies to the States. The Takings Clause of the Fifth Amendment has no correlate in the Fourteenth Amendment but it applies to the States through operation of law as does the Second Amendment.

Your right to keep and bear arms means precisely that you have the inalienable right to acquire and own and hold indefinitely, or transfer without government interference, those arms you bear and keep. The private property right and interest in your firearms must, then, be regarded as a tacit part of the Second Amendment's guarantee. This surely is as the Founders of the Republic intended. The firearms you have a right to bear and keep are your private property, not the State's. You have full and complete title to them, absolute control over them, and exclusive

rights in them. To denigrate a person's ownership interest in his firearms is to abrogate the Second Amendment right to bear and keep them.

So, in defending our Second Amendment right to keep and bear arms we must never lose sight of the equally important private property interest inherent in and coextensive with that Second Amendment right.

Tennessee Firearms Association joins amicus brief in 9th Circuit case involving state law restrictions on firearms purchases.

On May 2, 2022, Tennessee Firearms Association joined with other national and state organizations to support an appeal to the 9th Circuit Court of Appeals of a case challenging and at the trial court level striking down certain state level infringements on firearms purchase procedures. The case is *Yukutake, et al, v. Shikada, et al.*, 9th Circuit 21-16756.

In this case, TFA is joining with Gun Owners of America, Inc., Gun Owners Foundation, Gun Owners of California, Heller Foundation, Oregon Firearms Federation, Virginia Citizens Defense League, Grass Roots North Carolina, America's Future, Inc., Conservative Legal Defense and Education Fund, and Restoring Liberty Action Committee in the ongoing effort in the federal courts to defeat infringements on our 2nd Amendment rights. Shaping state and federal law in the courts is considered particularly necessary when state legislators and governors are unwilling to do so through the legislative process or by forcing the federal government to abide by the 2nd and 10th Amendments.

Hawaii has severe restrictions on firearms ownership. Two of those laws were challenged in this case. One law requires a permit to purchase a handgun but the permit is valid for only one purchase and expires in 10 days. The second law required all owners to personally bring newly acquired firearms to the police station for registration. The Plaintiffs challenged the constitutionality of these laws. Hawaii claimed that the laws were constitutional under an "intermediate scrutiny" standard that is so often applied not only by courts but as we see in Tennessee is often applied by legislators who are considering whether existing and proposed laws can be enacted.

In June 2021, the federal district court that heard the case granted summary judgment to the Plaintiffs and struck down both Hawaii laws as unconstitutional. The court applied an intermediate scrutiny standard, which the plaintiffs had argued was

too deferential. However, the district court struck down the laws even under the more lenient standard. Hawaii has appealed to the 9th Circuit.

TFA viewed this as an important case to get involved with because it will present the issue to a federal appellate court, in a case that could end up in the U.S. Supreme Court, on what the appropriate standard of review is when examining the constitutionality of a state law that restricts or infringes a firearms interest. Setting this standard to a level much higher than "intermediate scrutiny" is important and could result in federal challenges to many of Tennessee's existing statutory restrictions - restrictions which have been brought to the attention of the Tennessee Legislature and Governor but which they have refused to repeal or address.

If you would like to support the effort of Tennessee Firearms Association to continue to be involved with federal and state litigation to protect and restore our rights, please considering becoming or renewing your membership. If you are already a member, please consider making a supplemental member contribution in an amount you feel is appropriate to this effort.

What Should You Do?

Tennessee needs to become a Second Amendment Sanctuary State. The legislature, the governor, and the attorney general must lead the effort to protect the citizens of the Volunteer State from abuses by the federal government. I'd ask that you contact your state representatives, the governor, and the attorney general and send them the following:

As a staunch supporter of the U.S. Constitution, especially our rights guaranteed by the Bill of Rights I respectfully urge you to protect your citizens from abuses by the federal government. I am also a firm believer in the Second Amendment. Thus, Joe Biden is about to offer you a large amount of taxpayer cash to impose his federal anti-Second Amendment agenda.

I urge you to reject what amounts to a bribe, to stand strong for gun rights and to refuse to enforce any anti-Second amendment federal law, regulation, rule, scheme or program.

I further urge you to direct every law enforcement agency under your jurisdiction to refuse to enforce, and refuse to assist in the enforcement of, any anti-Second Amendment federal law, regulation, rule, scheme or program.

I hope that you will take a stand for my constitutional rights and make our great state a Second Amendment sanctuary state.
