ORSA COMPLETES SPRING AND FALL RIFLE CLINICS

ORSA High-Power shooters completed two clinics this Spring, totaling over 30 shooters this year. Shooters were able to learn more about Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) and ORSA's High-Power competitions as well as gain fundamental marksmanship instruction. This year saw the introduction of "Rimfire Sporter" as a first step in the process and introduced shooters to the fundamentals and use of a military style sling for support. Rimfire Sporter was introduced in the anticipation of an upcoming series of Rimfire Sporter Matches to be held in 2023. Also new this year, the rimfire portions were held at the indoor range and for larger classes the outdoor competition range was used.

Upon completion of the basic rimfire sporter clinic, some shooters attended the high-power service rifle clinic generally held a month later. New for the high-power clinic the club rifles were fitted with 4.5 power scopes. These scopes meet current NRA and CMP rules for service rifle matches.

We expect to have a similar clinic schedule next year, so look for announcements in the Rangefinder, as well as orsar-nadp.com/hp-events

ATTENTION BLACK POWDER ENTHUSIASTS UPDATE

We are looking for additional black powder enthusiasts to join us who share the enjoyment of old school firearms to join us to compare notes, swap lies, tall tales, and have fun while shooting black powder.

As our first year winds down we will take the month of December off. For the shorter daylight months will continue to meet on the first Thursday of the month but earlier AT 1:00 PM AS LONG AS THE TEMPERATURE IS ABOVE 50 degrees

- WHERE:** ORSA Range

INTRODUCING RIMFIRE SPORTER MATCHES

ORSA Rifle and Pistol club is planning to introduce CMP Games Rimfire Sporter matches in 2023. What is Rimfire Sporter? Rimfire Sporter was conceived at the Wolf Creek Olympic Shooting Complex near Atlanta in 1998 as an alternative to traditional smallbore rifle target competitions. Rimfire Sporter has become an ideal way to introduce youth and adults to the excitement and challenges of rifle target shooting with minimal expense and complication. A founding concept was to make this a game everyone could shoot by letting them use rimfire plinking and hunting rifles that many already own. The idea is to bring out your .22 rifle, have some fun, and work on your marksmanship skills. You can even borrow a club target rifle.

Rimfire Sporter rules are crafted so all types of small-bore rifles can be used, whether they are semi-automatics or manually operated, with separate classes for telescopic and open-sighted rifles. Rimfire Sporter rifles are .22LR caliber and limited to 7.5 pounds (including sights and a magazine) and must have triggers that lift at least 3.0 pounds and must be configured as standard sporter rifles. No specialized shooting jackets or other performance-enhancing equipment is allowed. A sling and heavy glove are allowed.

The Rimfire Sporter course of fire was modeled after the high-power rifle National Match Course. Three posi-

tions, prone, sitting or kneeling, and standing are used. The course includes both slow-fire and rapid-fire stages for each position. Rimfire Sporter matches can be shot outdoors at 50 yards prone and sitting and 25 yards standing, and inside using 50-foot reduced targets. We plan to offer both types of matches depending on time of year and range availability.

In addition, we are planning to open these matches to many other types of .22LR rifles, including "Military Trainers" and "Service Rifles", all of which typically weigh more than 7.5 lbs. Military trainers include target rifles such as Springfield M1922, Winchester M69 and M75, Remington 513T and 541X, Mossberg M144 and M44, and many others including foreign military rifles. Service Rifles will typically be AR-15 pattern rifles that exceed the weight limit.

By the time you get this issue the mid-term elections will be over. I sure hope you voted for the politicians that would protect our rights. We'll know whether the Republicans muster enough support for the majorities in both houses of Congress. Control of congress is important because there needs to be a counter to the anti-freedom and especially the anti-gun proclivities of the Biden Administration. The current Democrat majority in the House has passed a number of anti-gun bills which have been held in check by both the 50-50 split in the Senate and the Senatorial requirement for a 60 vote approval of legislation.

In the last year we Second Amendment advocates had a huge victory in *New York State Rifle & Pistol Association v. Bruen*. The U.S. Supreme Court ruled that states cannot, without a good reason, deny your right to carry a firearm for protection outside of your home. You and I helped in that decision by voting for Donald Trump and his being able to get three justices appointed to the Supreme Court.

But even with that victory, all is not good. In response to the Uvalde School shooting and immense pressure from all sides of the anti-gun left and the foolhardy notion that "we must do something," there was legislation passed into law that enacted "red-flag" laws. No Republicans in the House voted for this meaningless law but too many "feel good" Republicans in the Senate supported it. That shows that we have too many Republicans who don't have the backbone to protect our Constitution. Neither of our two Senators supported this law.

The Democrat House passed a number of anti-2A bills but hasn't been able to get support in the current Senate. They passed bills that

would outlaw semi-automatic rifles and would repeal the Protection of Lawful Commerce in Arms Act which protect gun manufacturers from frivolous lawsuits. If the Democrats get control of the House and the Senate, it is assured that these bills would become law.

While all this is going on Americans are suffering from the policies of the Biden Administration. There are four big issues before the American people; the inflation ridden economy; crime; the open border; and the destruction of the energy sector. For the purpose of this article I'll address two of these issues, crime and the open border. These two issues are linked and both are self-inflicted by the poli-

cies of the Biden Administration and the liberal left. It seems criminals and illegal immigrants are more protected than the American people. We have many states that have abolished bail for criminals and criminals are back on the street faster than the police can do the paperwork. Then we have leftist backed District Attorneys who refuse to charge criminals which puts these criminals right back on the street.

No country can survive without borders and not prosecuting those that enter the country illegally. Yet here we are. We have allowed up to five million illegals into this country without even a cursory background check. People from over 120 countries have been pouring across our borders - terrorists and criminals, most certainly. Venezuela has openly announced that they are emptying their prisons and sending them north.

As a result of these policies crime is out of control. Using the FBI's own data murders have increased 30% from 2019 to 2020, the highest rate in 25 years. The citizens of New Orleans, Chicago, New York, Detroit, St. Louis, Seattle, Philadelphia, Minneapolis, Indianapolis, and Washington DC are living in fear for their children and themselves.



Rapes, assaults, robberies, and car-jackings are at an all-time high. In 2021 the murders of police officers increased 60% and so far this year police officer murders have increased 19% when compared to last year.

Add to this the “Defund the Police” movement has meant less police to protect the people. I heard recently the response time for a 911 call in New Orleans was two hours!

So with our cities and neighborhoods awash in criminals, who feel immune from any time behind bars, and illegal immigrants, who were criminals in the country of origin, the American people have started arming themselves. It is estimated that there are 100 million Americans who own 400 million guns with 24.4 million of them AR-type rifles. In 2021 18.5 million Americans bought guns with 5.4 million of them buying a gun for the first time.

Yet in the world of the gun control crowd the American “problem” with guns is the American citizen, NOT the criminals nor the illegal immigrants.

- [U.S Post Office Admits to Spying on Gun Owners](#), NOT ‘legally authorized.’ A FOIA obtained by Cato Institute senior fellow Patrick Eddington shows that the United States Postal Service (USPS) inspectors have been monitoring pro-gun activists. The USPS Internet Covert Operations Program (iCOP) monitored the social media accounts of gun rights advocates from September 2020 through April 2021. The postal inspectors tracked the online activities of gun activists that attended Virginia Citizens Defense League’s (VCDL) “Lobby Day” and protests over the killing of Breonna Taylor. These actions alarmed Mr. Eddington. “The Post Office has no business devoting a cent of taxpayer money to monitoring groups involved in the political process,” Eddington told AmmoLand News. “Those officials who authorized or otherwise participated in this iCOP program who are still on the federal payroll should be fired and the program terminated.” <https://www.ammoland.com/2022/10/postal-service-spying-warrants-serious-response/#ixzz7glbL3ZvE>
- [Democrats Send Intimidation Letters, Putting Pressure On Shipping Companies](#). Letters from May 2022 turned up by AmmoLand News show that the Democrats in the Senate started pushing freight companies and shipping companies to crack down on gun shipments. Recently AmmoLand News has reported on UPS and FedEx cracking down on gun shipments. First, UPS changed its policy surrounding unfinished frames and receivers. The shipping giant informed customers that dealt in what the Biden Administration calls “ghost guns” that their accounts were canceled. UPS even told customers that if it found any packages containing the targeted items, it would destroy them. At the time, one retailer from Florida claimed to have \$30,000 in products in the mail. Markey (D-MA), the group contends, “For decades, the firearms industry has marketed firearms to consumers as a safe and proven product

to protect themselves and their homes. - [New York’s Concealed Carry Social Media Background Checks are Meant to Weed Out Political Views That Disagree With Those In Power](#). I’ve called upon and working closely [sic] with our attorney general to identify what’s going on in social media. Those questions are now part of our background check, such as like in the old days you’d talk to someone’s neighbor. - [Ban on Individuals Obtaining Firearms while Under Indictment is Unconstitutional](#). On September 19, 2022, the District Court, W.D. Texas, found the ban on individuals under indictment from receiving firearms in federal law, (§ 922(n)) to be unconstitutional under the standards clarified by the Bruen Decision of 2022. In the United States, people are considered innocent until proven guilty. If a mere indictment can eliminate the ability to exercise an enumerated constitutional right before there is any conviction, that standard is set on its head.

GUN AND 'DISINFORMATION' CONTROL SHOW TYRANNY IS GROWING

"New Zealand Prime Minister Jacinda Ardern called for tighter regulations on Internet speech, suggesting that 'disinformation' should be treated like gun control," The Daily Fetched reported Saturday, citing her address to the United Nations General Assembly. "Ardern called for 'disinformation' to be treated like bullets, bombs, or nuclear weapons, arguing that 'a lie online or from a podium' does not immediately kill people like the 'weapons of old' but could be more dangerous in the long run."

"We came together as communities to minimize these threats, Ardern declared. "We created international rules, norms, and expectations. We never saw that as a threat to our individual liberties - rather, it was preservation of them."

She's literally saying "freedom is slavery." In Ardern's case, especially in bringing it to the UN, that's an appropriate translation.

"Global Socialist Leads New Zealand Disarmament Drive," I wrote for Firearms News a few years back. "Look at New Zealand as a canary in a coal mine of sorts. This is what we have to look forward to if the globalist socialists here continue with their long march toward totalitarianism."

When government becomes the arbiter of what is allowed and what is deemed disinformation, anyone with different views can forget about having their heard. They'll be lucky if they're only ignored.

Let me give you an example of the type of "gun reporting" New Zealand demonstrated 12 years ago when the Tarnaki Daily News published a column wherein their "reporter" recounted her recent trip to Texas.

"Sitting down for dinner at any Texan diner, in my experience, often involves guns," columnist Rachel Stewart told her readers. "I can't recall the exact number of times I have eaten a meal in the immediate company of a man, or men, with shooters on their hips in plain view. For me, I am always equal parts spellbound and queasy. Spellbound because there is something so fundamentally cowboy and western about it. Guns, freedom, country music, and the Second Amendment. It is Texas after all. Yeeha!"

The one thing she said that was true was that she couldn't recall the exact number of times. That's because at the time her ridiculing hit piece was written, Texas was not yet an open carry state.

I called her on what was obviously "disinformation" and was met back with denials, excuses, and published name-calling and insults from the columnist and her editor in which they threw everything back at my provable observations but the truth.

I recall this story to illustrate just the type of public discourse on guns that will be allowed in New Zealand and elsewhere if Ardern and her globalist partners in disarmament and censorship have their way. And in the U.S. too, if we listen to who - what I call the DSM - passes off as its token "conservative."

"[Jennifer Rubin] (long cited by the [Washington] Post as their 'Republican columnist' for balance) has called for the media to abandon balance and impartiality," Jonathan Turley reports. "Rubin is demanding that the media just become overt advocates in refusing to report both sides in the myriad of political issues in this election."

"That balance was once called 'journalism' but Rubin now calls it

facilitating 'disinformation,'" Turley explains. "Balanced reporting is now dangerous and makes the media 'a megaphone for disinformation, upholding the pretense that there are two political parties with equally valid takes on reality.'"

Rubin is one of those Vichycon collaborators along the lines of "Republicans for Biden" as represented by The Lincoln Project and "conservative" William Kristol's Defending Democracy Together. A while back she was demanding "'rules' that would prohibit media outlets from treating Republicans as 'normal.'"

So naturally, she comes down squarely on the same side as Ardern when it comes to guns, issuing screeds claiming:

"Already awash with guns, the country has instead witnessed a further relaxation of reasonable gun restrictions. Age limits have been lowered. Gun licensing requirements have been repealed. Gun owners have been allowed to carry concealed weapons."

"This is gun fetish run amok. Republican politicians pose with weapons of war in campaign ads and shoot at whatever object can be most dramatically destroyed. No sane society would permit this."

They don't want you to have guns and they don't want you to have free speech. Hey, if you can get away with ignoring the Second Amendment, why should you respect the First?

The observable truth is that violence monopolists demand all the power. Every

bit of it. That's why they're called totalitarians.

If the globalists have their way, "disinformation" will be whatever they say it is. Forget arguing against the safety and effectiveness of Covid shots, questioning "climate change," objecting to the sexualization of children, challenging election result narratives, decrying open borders, criticizing the state enforcement apparatus, exploring the results of "a woman's right to choose," disputing critical race theory, disapproving "equity," opposing "commonsense gun safety laws"...

And don't forget the "systemic racism" built into the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution, and all that "disinformation" in the Bible...

Everyone realizes that the UN's Universal Declaration of Human Rights gives the rulers an "out," right?

In the exercise of his rights and freedoms, everyone shall be subject only to such limitations as are determined by law solely for the purpose of securing due recognition and respect for the rights and freedoms of others and of meeting the just requirements of morality, public order and the general welfare in a democratic society.

These rights and freedoms may in no case be exercised contrary to the purposes and principles of the United Nations.

That's the opposite of the unalienable Bill of Rights culture established by the Framers of the Constitution. Rendering citizens defenseless and then muzzling them is so "alien" to every principle traditional Americans cherish that it suggests a paraphrasing of a famous movie tag line:

In a police state, no one can hear you scream.
