## Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Highpower Rifle Clinic and CMP Games Match

**April 22 & September 23, 2023, 8:00 AM - ORSA Ed T. Johnson Indoor Range Facility**

We will meet at ORSA's Ed T. Johnson Indoor Range Facility on April 22, 2023, and September 23, 2023. Attendance at a basic rifle clinic is required before attending a highpower rifle clinic, or prior marksmanship training and evidence of prior competitive experience. The purpose of the clinic is to refine basic marksmanship fundamentals learned in the basic clinic, particularly the use of the sling. New for 2023 ORSA will host an OPTIONAL CMP Games Match immediately afterwards.

ORSA will provide your choice of an AR-15 or M1 Garand, with ammo. With prior coordination, you may request to bring your own US Service Rifle (AR-15, M1-Garand, or M-1A and ammo) provided it meets current CMP rules. If you are permitted to bring your gear, cost is \$10.00. If you are using an ORSA rifle, ammo, and equipment; cost is \$40.00 for use of AR, \$60 for the use of M1 Garand.

**If you wish to participate, please read, and follow the instructions below.**

RSVP to David Kiefer [orsaclinic@gmail.com](mailto:orsaclinic@gmail.com), Answer the following questions:

- What is your name, email address, and age?
- Are you furnishing your own rifle and ammo? If you are, provide details to ensure CMP compliance. (just google CMP Highpower Rules)
- Or, Will you need a club AR-15(or M1)? (note, only club ammo may be fired in club rifles)
- Are you left-handed?
- Do you plan to attend the optional CMP Games Match Afterwards?
- You will then get a confirmation email which will have additional information.

Once you have received your confirmation email you must notify us before Wednesday before the clinic if you cannot attend so others may take your spot. If you do not provide a cancelation notice, your participation in future clinics will not be guaranteed.

### **The Day of the Class:**

- Schedule: Report to the ORSA Ed T. Johnson Indoor Range Facility at 8:00 AM Saturday.
- Firing will be complete by 4:00 PM.
- You will register, receive an introductory course of instruction and will be assigned a shooting relay and target number before being released to the high power range
- All firing will be conducted from the 200 Yard Line.
- Upon reporting to the firing line, you will be paired with a coach and fitted with a shooting jacket and glove.
- Upon reporting to the pits, you will learn target scoring procedures.

### **Fees (Cash or check made out to ORSA):**

- \$40.00 (\$60 for M1) for club rifle, ammo, and equipment
- \$10.00 if participant brings their own rifle, equipment and ammo

### **Range Requirements, Safety, and Comfort:**

- Space is limited,
- Eye and Ear Protection are required on all ORSA ranges and must be furnished by participants.
- Dress for the weather predicted, to include a hat and sunscreen. An inclement weather plan exists in the event of rain.
- **No Muzzle Brakes**, shooters and coaches are near each other on the firing line.
- **Bring plenty to drink, and a light lunch.**

In my research for this monthly article I see charts from various sources where Tennessee is depicted as having constitutional carry. Do we? "If Tennessee is a constitutional carry state why does the law say it is a crime to carry with the intent to go armed?" The Tennessee Legislature is debating this during this session. There are bills for consideration that would in fact make Tennessee a true constitutional carry state. The governor and his minions oppose those bills in the house and senate. The Tennessee Firearms Association (which I'd recommend you be a member) has been fighting for true constitutional carry for years. Below is an excellent summary of the issue:

### **Tennessee does not have REAL Constitutional Carry - the talking points.**

We are in early voting in Tennessee and there are lots of individuals running for governor and the state Legislature. Many of them, including incumbents, are claiming that a) they are 2nd Amendment supporters and b) that they voted for "constitutional carry".

Before you vote, know the truth. The truth is Tennessee has NEVER had real constitutional carry in the last 200+ years and it does not today.

REAL "constitutional carry" means that it is not a crime to carry a firearm for a lawful purpose, such as self-defense. Nor is it a crime to carry a firearm in most places - including public places - unless the place falls into a very narrow and limited exception.

Tennessee's laws fail that standard.

First, Tennessee has Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-17-1307(a)(1) which says "A person commits an offense who carries, with the intent to go armed, a firearm or a club." That means it is a crime to carry any firearm in Tennessee "with the intent to go armed". That law is broad that it is even a crime to carry a firearm with the intent to go armed on your own property, in your own home, or even with a permit. That is a true statement because Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-17-1308 makes each of those factors "defenses" to the criminal charge. When something is a "defense" or an "exception" to a criminal charge, the burden is on the citizen to prove to a law enforcement officer or a jury that the individual's conduct satisfied the elements of the defense.

Now, many police officers would not arrest or charge someone if they clearly could demonstrate the existence of facts supporting the defense - but the officer has the discretion to do so.

Even the 2021 "permitless carry" law, which many have erroneously referred to as constitutional carry" has at least 7 elements or conditions to its application. Further, it is also written as an "exception" which means that the burden is on the individual to prove that the individual satisfies all of those conditions.

Second, Tennessee also fails the REAL "constitutional carry" standard because of part of what Bill Lee offered and the Legislature passed in 2021 in his "permitless carry" law. As part of the 2021 law, they added Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-17-1307(g) which is the operative language of the permitless carry law. However, it does not apply to

everyone who can lawfully purchase or possess a firearm. It only applies to handguns. It only applies to individuals who can meet the other qualifications under that subsection - such as the age limit qualification and/or the provision that requires that the individual "is in a place where the person is lawfully present."

Third, Tennessee fails the REAL "constitutional carry" standard because of another part of what Bill Lee offered and the Legislature passed in 2021 in his "permitless carry" law. As part of the 2021 law, they added Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-17-1307(h). At least three subparts of (h) make it a crime for people who can otherwise legally purchase or possess firearms to carry those firearms "with the intent to go armed."

Fourth, Tennessee fails REAL "constitutional carry" because it has many "prohibited places" statutes that make in crimes to possess firearms in some specific places (e.g., schools or public parks) but also any other place that might be "posted". The problem is that the 2nd Amendment never contemplated that these areas would be subject to government regulation. In fact, the United States Supreme Court just ruled to that effect in June 2022 when it decided the case of New York Rifle and Pistol Association v. Bruen. The Supreme Court essentially said if the right to carry or the manner or place of carry was not regulated by a law in 1791 (or in some instances in 1876) then it probably can't be regulated constitutionally today.

REAL constitutional carry means that it is simply not a crime for someone who can lawfully possess a firearm to carry it for any lawful purpose - including self-defense. REAL constitutional carry means that unconstitutional geographic and other restrictions on what, when and where you can carry a firearm do not exist.

So, be prepared when these elected officials and candidates start talking about Tennessee and whether it had constitutional carry. If they can't get that right, do they need to be in public office to protect your

other rights?



**2022 Closes with A Nation On the Precipice of Ruination**

As one more year draws rapidly to a close in these first three decades of the 21st Century, the United States stands precariously at the edge of an abyss.

One Branch of the Federal Government, the U.S. Supreme Court, at least recognizes the danger and has prevented the Country from falling over the precipice.

After a century of sidestepping the issue, the U.S. Supreme Court established, in three precedential case law decisions, what had been visibly plain in the language of the Second Amendment itself all along if one would only look.

All three cases were handed down in the first three decades of the 21st Century. They include:

*District of Columbia vs. Heller in 2008, McDonald vs. City of Chicago in 2010, and New York State Rifle & Pistol Association vs. Bruen in 2022.*

These three cases, together, stand for the following propositions, now black letter law:

**The right of armed self-defense is an individual right unconnected with one's service in a militia.**

**The right of armed self-defense is a universal right, applicable to both the States and the Federal Government.**

**The right of armed self-defense applies wherever a person is, inside the home or outside it.**

These three legal axioms are, together, the singular Law of the Land.

**But for this Law, the Republic would have fallen into ruin, this Century.**

There would be nothing to rein in a rogue Congress, a rogue Biden Administration, or rogue jurisdictions like those around the Country: New York, New Jersey, Illinois, California, Washington State, Washington D.C., Oregon, Hawaii, and several others.

The rot from those State jurisdictions and from the Federal Government would eventually infect many other states.

Forces inside the Government and outside it, both here and abroad—wealthy and powerful, malevolent and malignant—constantly machinate to destroy the right to armed self-defense. These forces will not tolerate an armed citizenry. The existence of an armed citizenry contradicts their end goal of a neo-feudalistic world government. The armed citizenry precept deviates from their plan of world conquest.

Their goal for the 21st Century is a return to the political, social, and economic feudalistic construct operating in the world of the 5th through 15th Centuries—the Middle Ages.

These ruthless elements have declared—

**The United States can no longer continue as a free Constitutional Republic;**

**The American people must be subjugated; and**

**Any thought of an armed citizenry must be erased from the collective memory of the American people.**

The ashes of a once powerful, respected, sovereign, independent United States are to be commingled with the ashes of other western nations.

The EU and the British Commonwealth Nations are a step in the direction of that world empire.

The neoliberal democratic world order is conceived as—

**One devoid of defined geographical borders,**

**One absent national government; and**

**One bereft of any defining history, heritage, culture, ethos, or Judeo-Christian ethic by which the people of one nation may easily distinguish themselves from any other.**

### **Bill of Rights**

Will the U.S. fall victim to totalitarianism as have the nations of the EU and British Commonwealth, as have India and China, and as have most all countries in the Middle East? Let us hope not.

The U.S. need not fall victim. The U.S. has something all other nations lack: a true Bill of Rights.

Our Bill of Rights consists of a set of natural laws: fundamental, unalienable, unmodifiable, immutable, illimitable, and eternal.

Within this Country's Bill of Rights rests a Cardinal Truth. And, of this Truth—

**The Founders were aware of it.**

**The Republic they founded is grounded on it.**

**The strength and power of our Country and the staying power of our Constitution is a testament to it.**

All Americans should imprint this Truth on their collective memory:

**“What isn't created by man cannot lawfully be taken from man by other men, nor by any temporal artifice of man: Government, for the sanctity, inviolability of man's Selfhood, his Soul, and his Spirit do not belong to the Government; they cannot be bestowed on man by Government; and they cannot be severed from man by Government.”**

### **Government is a dangerous enterprise.**

Our Federal Government is no longer reliable. It is entirely rogue. It has forgotten the people whose interests it was created to serve. It serves only its own interests, those special interests that fund the campaign coffers, and foreign, secretive agencies of whom the public has no inkling.

With this Federal Government, the American people have got “a tiger by the tail.” It is difficult to hold onto, but one daren't let it go lest it bite the people. Best to destroy it if we can no longer hold onto it.

That “Tiger,” our Federal Government, is a creation of the American people and exists only to serve the people—the true and sole sovereign over the Federal Government.

**The presence of an armed citizenry serves as both evidence of its sovereignty over the Government and the mechanism by which it may lawfully constrain it, contain it, or curtail it if the Government loses its way and turns against the people.**

**The Right to Armed Self-Defense is Natural Law, a God-given right bestowed on man by the Divine Creator.**

**Government cannot lawfully modify Natural Law, ignore it, Rescind it, or formally Repeal it.**

Since armed self-defense is a Natural Law Right, the U.S. Supreme Court—in Heller, McDonald, and Bruen—didn't make new law. The rulings of the three seminal High Court cases simply make explicit what is tacit in the language of the Second Amendment.

Unfortunately, many jurisdictions have failed to recognize, or otherwise have failed to acknowledge and accept, the strictures of the Second Amendment.

That necessitated the intervention of the High Court. In one Second Amendment case after another—from Heller to McDonald and then to Bruen—the Court has ordered States to uphold the strictures of the Second Amendment. Yet, many refuse to do so.

Indeed, many jurisdictions reject Heller, McDonald, and Bruen outright. But no jurisdiction does so more emphatically, contemptuously, and openly than New York. And a recent ruling of the Second Circuit is disheartening and unnerving.
