## **Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Highpower Rifle Clinic and CMP Games Match September 23, 2023, 8:00 AM – ORSA Ed T. Johnson Indoor Range Facility**

We will meet at ORSA's Ed T. Johnson Indoor Range Facility on September 23, 2023. Attendance at a basic rifle clinic is required before attending a highpower rifle clinic, or prior marksmanship training and evidence of prior competitive experience. The purpose of the clinic is to refine basic marksmanship fundamentals learned in the basic clinic, particularly the use of the sling. New for 2023, ORSA will host and OPTIONAL CMP Games Match immediately afterwards.

ORSA will provide your choice of an AR-15 or M1 Garand, with ammo. With prior coordination, you may request to bring your own US Service Rifle (AR-15, M1-Garand, or M-1A and ammo) provided it meets current CMP rules. If you are permitted to bring your gear, cost is \$10.00. If you are using an ORSA rifle, ammo, and equipment; cost is \$40.00 for use of AR, \$60 for the use of M1 Garand.

**If you wish to participate, please read, and follow the instructions below.**

- What is your name, email address, and age?
- Are you furnishing your own rifle and ammo? If you are, provide details to ensure CMP compliance. (just google CMP Highpower Rules)
- Or, Will you need a club AR-15(or M1)? (note, only club ammo may be fired in club rifles)
- Are you left-handed?
- Do you plan to attend the optional CMP Games Match Afterwards?
- You will then get a confirmation email which will have additional information.

Once have received your conformation email, if you find you are unable to attend, please notify us before Wednesday September 20th. There may be a waiting list and your spot can be filled from the list. If you do not provide a cancelation notice, your participation in future clinics will not be guaranteed.

### **The Day of the Class:**

- Schedule: Report to the ORSA Ed T. Johnson Indoor Range Facility at 8:00 AM Saturday.
- Firing will be complete by 4:00 PM.
- You will register, receive an introductory course of instruction and will be assigned a shooting relay and target number before being released to the high power range
- All firing will be conducted from the 200 Yard Line.
- Upon reporting to the firing line, you will be paired with a coach and fitted with a shooting jacket and glove.
- Upon reporting to the pits, you will learn target scoring procedures.

### **Fees (Cash or check made out to ORSA):**

- \$40.00 (\$60 for M1) for club rifle, ammo, and equipment
- \$10.00 if participant brings their own rifle, equipment and ammo

### **Range Requirements, Safety, and Comfort:**

- Space is limited,
- Eye and Ear Protection are required on all ORSA ranges and must be furnished by participants.
- Dress for the weather predicted, to include a hat and sunscreen. An inclement weather plan exists in the event of rain.
- **No Muzzle Brakes**, shooters and coaches are near each other on the firing line.
- **Bring plenty to drink, and a light lunch.**

The propagandists in the media and the political class have laid the groundwork for a new bogeyman, and they are using that bogeyman to undermine the U.S. Constitution. They are the foundation of our government, and they are blithely attacking our Nation's fundamental rights. That bogeyman is you and me.

The forces that dare crush our Nation into submission have taken over the reins of Government. With the ouster of Trump and with control over two of three Branches of Government, and with that of the Judiciary, the third, on the radar, the forces that intend to destroy a free Constitutional Republic have attained much of their first goal. The second goal is now to rein in the sovereign American people themselves.

How do you destroy the sovereignty of the American people? Get them to accept the false and dangerous notion that their fundamental, natural, unalienable, immutable, illimitable rights are no longer necessary. That the Democrat Party agenda, when put into policy, can better "serve" the American people. That all will be well with the world once the Nation's old, archaic, racist, anachronistic Bill of Rights is erased, and once the plain meaning of the Articles of the U.S. Constitution is modified, upended, reinterpreted, formally dispensed with, or, simply, ignored.

Our representative republic is in trouble. Crime in cities is out of control. Murder, rape, carjacking, and theft crimes are breaking records all across the country. Many, if not most, of these crimes include the use of weapons, all the while these cities and states have the toughest gun control laws in America. Leftist backed prosecutors are letting criminals out of jail faster than the police can file the arrest paperwork. The U.S. Supreme Court issues another ruling supporting the Second Amendment and the next day several states and cities pass new laws flouting their opposition to the Supreme Court ruling. Biden issues Executive Orders, one after the other attacking citizens right to keep and bear arms. A report from a panel of DOD "experts" entitled "Preventing Suicide in the U.S. Military: Recommendations from the Suicide Prevention and Response Independent Review Committee" recommends various gun control measures under the guise of suicide prevention. The panel's recommendations include:

- A seven-day waiting period for any firearms purchased on DOD property.
- Raising the minimum age for buying guns and ammo to 25

- Developing a national database for recording firearm serial numbers
- Prohibiting the possession of privately owned firearms not related to the performance of official duties on DOD property by anyone who does not live on DOD property.
- Requiring anyone living on DOD property in military housing to register all privately owned firearms with a base authority.
- Restricting the possession and storage of privately owned firearms in barracks and dormitories.

So, while the military is facing huge recruiting problems, the U.S. military is now saying come join us, be prepared to fight and die for your country, but we don't trust you enough to own a private firearm. We're telling prospective and current military members that we are going to strip away the same rights you are supposedly fought and died to preserve.

### CA Governor Proposes a 28th Amendment

California Gov. Gavin Newsom recently proposed an almost certain DOA constitutional amendment mandating gun control. Early last month, Newsom proposed a 28th Amendment, which covers these tenets:

- Raising the federal minimum age to purchase a firearm from 18 to 21.
- Mandating universal background checks to prevent truly dangerous people from purchasing a gun that could be used in a crime.
- Instituting a reasonable waiting period for all gun purchases; and
- Barring civilian purchase of assault weapons that serve no other purpose than to kill as many people as possible in a short amount of time - weapons of war our nation's founders never foresaw.

If Joe Biden and his handlers decide that he can no longer keep up the charade that is his presidency, Gavin Newsom will be the leading candidate to run in 2024.

### Stop Gov. Lee and His Red Flag Law July 4, 2023

Celebrate the freedom from tyranny that was the bedrock of this nation but take a moment to defend it as well!

These sovereign states and this Nation exist because those who came before us fought a tyrant to seize freedom and establish a nation where liberty was intended to thrive.
