ORSA Skeet, Trap & Sporting Clays sub-club sponsored a squad of five youth skeet shooters that competed in the Tennessee State Skeet Championships on Saturday August 19th at Crossville Shooting Sports Park. An ORSA member also shot in the Senior Division at the Championships.

In the 12-gauge event a total of 34 competitors shot skeet for individual, class and concurrent titles.

The following shooters from ORSA placed in the top 3 as follows:

Luke Lankford was runner up in the 12-gauge event with a score of 100x100. He was edged out of first place by an AA class shooter in a shoot-off. Congratulations to Luke for being one of only two perfect scores of 100x100 in the 12-gauge event!

Lee Moulton won the 12-gauge C class in a shoot off with another junior shooter from Maryville, TN. They had scores of 98x100. Lee held on for the win in the shoot off.

Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Highpower Rifle Clinic and CMP Games Match September 23, 2023, 8:00 AM – ORSA Ed T. Johnson Indoor Range Facility

We will meet at ORSA's Ed T. Johnson Indoor Range Facility on September 23, 2023. Attendance at a basic rifle clinic is required before attending a highpower rifle clinic, or prior marksmanship training and evidence of prior competitive experience. The purpose of the clinic is to refine basic marksmanship fundamentals learned in the basic clinic, particularly the use of the sling. New for 2023, ORSA will host and OPTIONAL CMP Games Match immediately afterwards.

ORSA will provide your choice of an AR-15 or M1 Garand, with ammo. With prior coordination, you may request to bring your own US Service Rifle (AR-15, M1-Garand, or M-1A and ammo) provided it meets current CMP rules. If you are permitted to bring your gear, cost is \$10.00. If you are using an ORSA rifle, ammo, and equipment; cost is \$40.00 for use of AR, \$60 for the use of M1 Garand.

If you wish to participate, please read, and follow the instructions below.

RSVP to David Kiefer orsaclicnic@gmail.com, Answer the following questions:

- What is your name, email address, and age?
- Are you furnishing your own rifle and ammo? If you are, provide details to ensure CMP compliance. (just google CMP Highpower Rules)
- Or, Will you need a club AR-15(or M1)? (note, only club ammo may be fired in club rifles)
- Are you left-handed?
- Do you plan to attend the optional CMP Games Match Afterwards?
- You will then get a confirmation email which will have additional information.

Once have received your conformation email, if you find you are unable to attend, please notify us before Wednesday September 20th. There may be a waiting list and your spot can be filled from the list. If you do not provide a cancelation notice, your participation in future clinics will not be guaranteed.

The Day of the Class:

- Schedule: Report to the ORSA Ed T. Johnson Indoor Range Facility at 8:00 AM Saturday.
- Firing will be complete by 4:00 PM.
- You will register, receive an introductory course of instruction and will be assigned a shooting relay and target number before being released to the high power range
- All firing will be conducted from the 200 Yard Line.
- Upon reporting to the firing line, you will be paired with a coach and fitted with a shooting jacket and glove.
- Upon reporting to the pits, you will learn target scoring procedures.

Fees (Cash or check made out to ORSA):

- \$40.00 (\$60 for M1) for club rifle, ammo, and equipment
- \$10.00 if participant brings their own rifle, equipment and ammo

Range Requirements, Safety, and Comfort:

- Space is limited,
- Eye and Ear Protection are required on all ORSA ranges and must be furnished by participants.
- Dress for the weather predicted, to include a hat and sunscreen. An inclement weather plan exists in the event of rain.
- **No Muzzle Brakes**, shooters and coaches are near each other on the firing line.
- **Bring plenty to drink, and a light lunch.**

New Leak Shows ATF Will Pass Rule to Eliminate Private Sales

The Biden administration will use executive orders and the

weaponized ATF to issue a rule limiting the private sales of firearms. According to the New York Times and verified by AmmoLand News sources, the new rule is expected to be unveiled by the end of the year.

President Joe Biden plans to announce that he is directing the ATF to close what Everytown calls the "private sales loophole" and the "digital loophole." The "private sales loophole" is when an individual sells a firearm for profit but does not possess a Federal Firearm License (FFL).

Biden will call on the ATF to develop a new rule requiring anyone who makes any profit by selling firearms to possess an FFL. Guns tend to increase in value over time. A gun purchased in 1980 will likely sell for more money today than its original value.

The so-called "digital loophole" includes marketplaces like Armslist Firearms Classified, where private individuals can list their firearms for sale. The Biden administration wants to see these marketplaces shut down, but it is unclear exactly how that unconstitutional goal will be accomplished. Websites like Armslist do not sell firearms directly.

AmmoLand News spoke to Armslist Founder Jonathan Gibbon about the attacks his company faces and the upcoming ATF rule. Armslist has been battling anti-gun groups for years, fending off several lawsuits. Armslist has a perfect track record at defeating these attacks, but the cases are costly.

"Private-party transactions are not a 'loophole,'" Gibbon told AmmoLand News. "Buying and selling firearms is a guaranteed right under the Second Amendment. Interfering with state laws allowing citizens to exercise their Second Amendment rights should concern everyone. Americans have a First Amendment Constitutional right to use the internet, to communicate about their other Constitutional rights."

The rule, currently in draft form, is expected to be announced later this year. The announcement will be followed by a public comment period. The Biden administration aims to reveal the final rule by late spring or early summer of 2024 and for it to go into effect by the fall of next year. The rule is still in the early stages of development, so the timeline is subject to change.

Previous ATF rule changes, such as the frame/receiver rule, bump stock rule, and pistol brace rule, have been successfully challenged in court. The courts have ruled that the ATF does not have the authority to pass these rules subverting the powers of Congress to make laws. In an attempt to head off another defeat, the ATF and the Justice Department will claim that the power to require private sellers to obtain an FFL was delegated to them by Congress through the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act (BSCA).

The BSCA was a massive gun control bill that passed Congress with the support of some Republicans. The bill changed the definition of a "gun seller." The BSCA altered the wording of Section 921(a) of Title 18, United States Code. The BSCA altered the definition of someone "engaged in the business" of selling guns from "with the principal objective of livelihood and profit" to the ambiguous statement of "to predominantly earn a profit." Now the Biden Administration is exploiting that change through the upcoming rule. From the text of the BSCA:

(22) The term 'to predominantly earn a profit' means that the intent underlying the sale or disposition of firearms is predominantly one of obtaining pecuniary gain, as opposed to other intents, such as improving or liquidating a personal firearms collection: Provided, That proof of profit shall not be required as to a person who engages in the regular and repetitive purchase and disposition of firearms for criminal purposes or terrorism.

Many gun rights groups tried to warn Republicans such as Senator John Cornyn, chief architect of the BSCA, that the Biden administration would exploit the anti-gun law, but these pleas were ignored.

The main force pushing for the new rule is Everytown for Gun Safety. The Bloomberg-backed anti-freedom group sees the new requirements for sellers to obtain an FFL to get closer to universal background checks (UBC). President Biden and other Democrat politicians have taken millions of dollars from the group and will need the organization's war chest for the upcoming elections.

Universal background checks have been a cornerstone of the Biden anti-gun plan, but so far have been a non-starter in Congress. With the President unable to pass any bill that includes UBCs, the White House is doing what it considers the next best thing.

This rule shows the gun community that any "compromise" will be used against gun rights, and the ATF claiming authority through the BSCA shows that the recent losses have the ATF scrambling to prevent future losses by pointing to legislation even if the law has to be taken out of context.

Anti-Gunners Downplay Gun Registry

In an attempt to downplay the argument that through the ATF, the federal government is creating a gun registry to track gun sales, Daniel Funke, a USA Today writer, made it a point to try and protect the ATF and diminish an alert by Gun Owners of America (GOA). GOA warned gun owners that the Biden Administration would likely confiscate firearms if given a gun registry. Although the gun-grabbers like to gaslight Americans by pretending confiscation could never happen in America, logical-thinking people aren't buying it. Gun confiscation has occurred in several countries and always leads to a loss of citizens' rights and more government control. The disarming of citizens often leads to their demise.

In a USA Today article, an anti-gun activist, Daniel Funke tried to support his claims that there is no gun registry with the following:

- ATF retains records from federally licensed firearms dealers, manufacturers, and importers that go out of business. The records include information about gun sales and transfers.
- The records are stored as digital images that can't be searched for identifying information. The repository is essentially a giant folder full of pictures of forms.
- ATF can only access the records if a law enforcement agency asks for help tracing a gun linked to a crime.

Somehow, the gun control activists over at USA Today, including Funke, who claims to be "a fact check reporter covering online misinformation," think this debunks the claims that the government is creating a registry even after admitting in his own article that the IRS manages a database of 920,664,765 firearm purchase records. The only argument "Funke the Fact Checker" presents against the claims of a federal gun registry, is that "records are not stored in a searchable database or a format consistent with a registry." You are supposed to believe that. The troubling thing is that the anti-gun mentality has cultivated the notion that any of this is acceptable at all. People

who don't know any better will consume any such anti-gun nonsense people like Daniel Funke feed to them.

Recently, a Montana gun shop was raided by 20 armed IRS Agents who confiscated 4473s which contained personal information from gun owners, including home addresses, social security numbers, and other sensitive data. The armed Agents occupied the gun shop for the entire day.

Montana Attorney General Austin Knudsen told Breitbart News that the IRS seizure of gun owner documents is "extremely concerning" because it appears to "exceed" the search warrant that was issued, which "limited the scope of the search to financial records." **"These aren't financial records, they're records of lawful firearm purchases," he said. "What the hell does the IRS need with 4473s? We know the ATF in Washington, DC is trying to scoop up as many of these purchase records as possible, and that's what it looks like they're trying to do here."** In this case, if the IRS was searching for a "gun linked to a crime," why would they need more than the one form 4473 related to the person in question?

Anti-gun fear-mongering has reached an all-time high, and the tracking of firearms in America is not only acceptable but an achievement or "progress" in the minds of the political left. The 2nd Amendment does not say, "the right of the people to keep, and bear arms shall not be infringed, as long as the government knows where your guns are located."

Our founding fathers never intended for the government to know who owned guns and the home addresses where they could be found. Their intent was the exact opposite. It was never any of the government's business.

Not only are the gun grabbers publicly expressing their intent to track and trace firearms, but they are also using unique and clever strategies to get as many people on board with the violation of their fellow citizens' rights. The latest is the "ghost gun" fear campaign. The "ghost gun" fear tactic is merely a strategy to convince those who don't know any better that these evil, dangerous, untraceable firearms are lurking around every corner, just waiting to attack. "But don't worry, those reckless Conservatives can be controlled, and the government can protect you from those scary 'ghost guns' if you just support legislation that would mandate the serialization of every firearm in America."

The truth is over 95% of guns used in crimes are already traceable. So, what is their real intent? If they're already able to trace criminals' guns, what other guns could they possibly be interested in?

"Ghost gun" legislation leads to serialization. Serialization and Universal Background Checks lead to a gun registry and "Red Flag Laws" are the tool by which confiscations are executed. We all know where gun registration ends up despite what anti-gun, politically biased "fact-checkers" tell us.
