“... the right of the people to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed.” This is plain language that you and I can understand. But not for the leftists, they try to twist the meaning for their own ends – banning the citizenry from owning arms. Ask yourself these questions – Why are all the gun control laws aimed at U.S. citizens? Is there an equal set of actions aimed at keeping criminals from getting firearms? Why is the government going after the citizen?

Any noble government that believes its law-abiding citizens must be restrained from owning or responsibly carrying firearms does not understand the difference between citizens and subjects. Our Founders clearly grasped the importance of We the People to defend ourselves against any threat that might arise – from personal confrontation to political tyranny. Citizens of a free society must take on certain responsibilities, or their helplessness would be unsustainable. The Second Amendment is our country’s clear, concise, and lawful acknowledgement of a God-given right of self-defense that in our land of the free and home of the brave is truly self-evident.

For this reason, any state statutes containing widespread prohibitions or overly burdensome regulations on the concealed carry of firearms must be immediately questioned. Law-abiding citizens should not require the consent of faceless bureaucrats to exercise their right to keep and bear arms, and no local politicians can override the Second Amendment or the natural right of self-preservation.

In the *Bruen* decision, the Supreme Court majority opinion was *“The constitutional right to bear arms in public for self-defense is not “a second-class right, subject to an entirely different body of rules than the other Bill of Rights guarantees. The exercise of other constitutional rights does not require individuals to demonstrate to government officers some special need. The Second Amendment right to carry arms in public for self-defense is no different. New York’s proper-cause requirement violates the Fourteenth Amendment by preventing law-abiding citizens with ordinary self-defense needs from exercising their right to keep and bear arms in public.”*

Undeterred by this ruling the leftists went to work. The state of NY immediately passed laws that were more restrictive. Now citizens of NY have to pay to have a State-run background check for both gun and ammo purchases (NY gun registry anyone?). NY is now working with the White House to get other states to join them in defying the SC decision.

Recently, the Governor of New Mexico declared a “health emergency” and nullified her citizens Second Amendment rights.

And Biden has used the ATF to target citizen’s with FFL’s, with their “zero tolerance” rule. In the first six months of 2023 the ATF has conducted 4,587 compliance inspections of FFL holders. The ATF revoked the licenses of 87 gun dealers across the country. What used to be a warning for clerical errors is now reason enough to revoke the FFL.

Congress passed, and Biden signed, the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act which focused on red flag laws. Now the federal government is using our tax dollars to bribe states to enact their own red flag laws. The point of these red flag laws is to set a precedent where the government can seize your lawfully-owned firearms without notice and without due process.

Federal law prohibits a national gun registry. But Biden’s ATF going full steam ahead to seize and to create a defacto national gun registry. In 2021, the ATF obtained 53.9 million paper records and 887,000 electronic records. Here’s the play for the ATF, inspect citizen with an FFL, find a typo in their records, then revoke their license, and take their records.

Of course, with leftists, words also have meaning, but meanings suddenly change based on corrupt collectivist goals. And we’re all required to accept this “new meaning” or be punished. Thus, the gullible are routinely told lies by woke “personal security experts,” who are unflinching mouthing the leftist playbook. These “experts” talk ad nauseam about “rules,” “orders of protection,” “red flag laws,” “restraining orders,” and “developing a personal safety plan.” Not surprisingly, their dubious “safety plans” never tell the soon-to-be homicide victims the following:

- 1) Resolve to forcefully resist (including with deadly force) murderous attackers. You have the right to continue living. They have no right to murder you!
- 2) Buy a gun, and learn how to use it effectively for “serious purposes.” It’s your Constitutional Right! When you desperately need a gun, there is no substitute that is even remotely adequate.
- 3) When the application of deadly force is necessary in order to preserve your life, at all times, be in a position to apply it with unapologetic decisiveness and precision.
- 4) Know that when incisive application of deadly force is the “solution,” it is usually the only solution.



- 5) Understand that sometimes, in order to save a life, you have to end a life. Resolve that, when necessary, you'll boldly step up to the plate without hesitation. Your life hinges on it!

You'll never hear any of the foregoing from the lips of soft-headed "security experts" who haunt TV news networks. Few among them are willing to face facts, at least in public. But you can bet they all own guns or at least pay for armed security that does, in order to protect themselves. They just won't talk about it! Hypocrites!

Biden Will Campaign on Gun Control; New Restrictions Coming

CNN reports that soon after Labor Day weekend, President Joe Biden will announce new gun control efforts, which include bringing together anti-gun state lawmakers from around the country for White House meetings.

A visit to Chicago last Friday by Vice President Kamala Harris was reportedly the first step in Biden's plan to "make gun safety a central issue of his reelection campaign." "Gun safety" translates to "gun control." The effort will almost certainly be tied to getting more Democrats elected at all levels. This much was acknowledged in the CNN report, which noted Michael Bloomberg's Everytown for Gun Safety "spent \$55 million on gun safety supporting candidates - at this point, almost exclusively Democrats - for a variety of offices in the 2020 cycle," and Everytown President John Feinblatt "said to expect more heavy spending in 2024."

While the Waco Tribune noted how gun control groups had come together early to endorse Biden for president next year, the re-election strategy reportedly includes a heavy emphasis on getting young voters to turn out for Biden next November.

Meanwhile, CNN's report, which referred to the gun control crowd as "gun safety advocates," said anti-gunners have been "pressing Biden advisers and other Democrats" on using guns as a campaign issue. They reportedly have polling data showing how the game plan must keep reminding voters that Republicans have been blocking gun control efforts, which allegedly "negates" GOP efforts to highlight rising crime under Biden and the Democrats.

The CNN report quoted anti-gun Connecticut Senator, Chris Murphy, who told the network, "Many of

us believe that this issue can be our ticket back to the House majority and to a big electoral win. And Biden is part of that group."

What this means to gun owners and Second Amendment activists is that they will have to work harder over the next 15 months to get out the vote, especially among pro-rights youth voters, and to support candidates who can win at all levels.

Biden's Proposed Rule Will Eliminate Private Gun Sales

President Joe Biden and the Department of Justice announced a proposed rule to change who will need a federal firearms license (FFL) to sell firearms.

The long-awaited rule was hailed by anti-gun groups like Everytown for Gun Safety, Giffords, and Brady United as a way of closing the "gun show loophole" and the "internet loophole." Anti-gun organizations claim this is a step towards universal background checks, a centerpiece of the Biden Administration's anti-gun policy.

The proposed rule is powered by the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act (BSCA), which was a law championed by Chris Murphy (D-CT) and John Cornyn (R-TX). The BSCA changed the law's wording to describe who the federal government considers a gun dealer. The bill altered the language of Section 921(a) of Title 18, United States Code. The BSCA changed the definition of someone "engaged in the business" of selling guns from "with the principal objective of livelihood and profit" to the ambiguous statement of "to predominantly earn a profit." Now, the Biden Administration is exploiting that change through the upcoming rule. At the time, some Republicans who backed the law blew off the concerns that an anti-gun administration would exploit the language. The change read:

(22) The term "to predominantly earn a profit" means that the intent underlying the sale or disposition of firearms is predominantly one of obtaining pecuniary gain, as opposed to other intents, such as improving or liquidating a personal firearms collection: Provided, that proof of profit shall not be required as to a person who engages in the regular and repetitive purchase and disposition of firearms for criminal purposes or terrorism.

The new rule will also affect those that sell multiples of the same type of firearms. This section means that

anyone who liquidates a collection of Glock pistols must acquire an FFL before they can liquidate the guns. Many people collect certain guns, and this would prevent the legal transfer of those firearms without an FFL.

Unlicensed sellers who sell through “online auctions” would be required to obtain an FFL under the proposed rule. This section is a targeted shot at sites like Armslist.

The rule would make it so that anyone who rents a table at a gun show will be assumed to be in the business of selling firearms, meaning that private citizens will no longer be able to sell their firearms at any gun show. Also, if someone advertises their firearms for sale, they could be assumed to be in the business of selling firearms, which will shut down most private sales.

By requiring more people to get FFLs, it will prevent a lot of Americans from selling guns. The secondary market has been an excellent way for those less fortunate to acquire the means of protection. Those who choose to get an FFL will be subject to unannounced warrantless inspections. These inspections have been used to revoke gun shop's FFLs under the Biden Administration's zero-tolerance policy.

FFL revocation is up between 350% and 500% and is currently at a 17-year high. The amount of record keeping, cost, and hostile environment created by the ATF could mean that many will not get an FFL to sell their firearms, which could be part of Biden's plan.

The government's argument is most criminals do not get their guns from gun dealers. That fact is true, but most criminals do not get firearms from legal transactions. Most guns used in crimes are obtained illegally through such means as theft, which means this rule will not prevent criminals from getting firearms.

“The U.S. Sentencing Commission reports that “88.8 percent of firearm offenders sentenced under §2K2.1130 [of the United States Sentencing Commission Guidelines Manual (Nov. 2021)] were [already] prohibited from possessing a firearm” under 18 U.S.C. 922(g). These individuals would thus have been flagged in a background check, would have therefore been prohibited from buying a firearm from a licensed dealer after their first offense, and would not have been able to commit the subsequent firearms offense(s) if their seller had been licensed.”

There will be an exception for gifting firearms between family members. Although this type of transfer only makes up a small portion of transfers. There will be a 90-day comment period once the proposed rule is posted to the federal registry. After the comment period, a final rule will be unveiled.”

From the National Associate for Gun Rights:

We have less than 90 days to demand the ATF cease

and desist their efforts to implement a national gun registry.

In case you missed it, under orders from the Biden Administration, the ATF released a new rule which, according to the White House, will “move as close to Universal {GUN REGISTRATION} as possible.”

The 90-day public comment period for this rule began on 8 September, and **we have until December 7th** to flood their portal with pro-gun messages opposing this unconstitutional rule.

Feel free to copy and paste this pre-drafted message into the online portal:

As a pro-gun American, I am calling on the ATF and the Department of Justice to withdraw ATF 2022R-17 at the proposed “Definition of Engaged in the Business as a Dealer in Firearms” rule.

If implemented, this rule would create a registry of law-abiding gun owners through the 4473 system, despite a universal gun registration system being ILLEGAL under Federal law.

Moreover, it is a clear violation of separation of powers, Congress has given the ATF NO additional authority to redefine gun dealer registration requirements. In fact, Congress has repeatedly VOTED DOWN efforts to expand “universal” gun registration schemes.

Enforcement of this rule would be in blatant violation of the Second Amendment and the Supreme Court's Bruen decision, as there ARE NO historical analogous regulations requiring background checks, dealer licensing, or gun registration from the Founding Fathers Era.

Therefore, I urge you to STOP this ILLEGAL and UNCONSTITUTIONAL action and withdraw ATF 2022R-17 at once.

Make no mistake about it, this rule is worse than what we initially predicted.

You see, the ATF is attempting to completely redefine what it takes for the ATF to consider you a “gun dealer” to ban outright all private firearm sales in America.

The ATF will label you as a “gun dealer” if you meet one or more of the following:

**** Offer for sale any number of firearms and also represents to potential buyers that they are willing and able to purchase and sell them additional firearms;*

**** Repetitively offer for sale firearms within 30 days after they were purchased;*

**** Repetitively offer for sale firearms that are like new in their original packaging;*

**** Repetitively offer for sale multiple firearms of the same make and model; or as a formerly federally-licensed firearms dealer, sell firearms that were in the business inventory and not transferred to a personal collection at least a year before the sale, addressing the so-called “fire sale loophole.”*

The language of the rule is intentionally vague and gives the ATF a blank check to prosecute anyone who even THINKS about selling a gun without government permission.

And if you violate any one of the countless hoops they put you through, Biden will send his ATF goon squad to throw you in prison. In fact, FFL fines and violations have gone up approximately 300% since March when Biden announced his FFL crackdown.

According to The New York Times, Biden's order will punish violators with five years in prison and a quarter million dollars in fines.
