## NEWS FROM SKEET, TRAP & SPORTING CLAYS



Hope you are able to get out and enjoy the pleasant change in the weather.

As you know we change some of the range hours in the four winter months. We change the hours in November, December, January and February.

**Trap hours** are Tuesday 11-2, Saturday 11-3, and Sunday 12-4.  
**Skeet hours** are Friday 11-2, Saturday 11-3, and Sunday 12-4.  
**Sporting Clays hours** are Friday 1-4, Saturday 10-4, and Sunday 1-4. We will not schedule ATA Big 50 trap shoots these months. They will start back first Tuesday in March weather permitting.

Shooting the full course with a group of 4, takes about 2 hours so please plan on starting at least 2 hours before closing time.

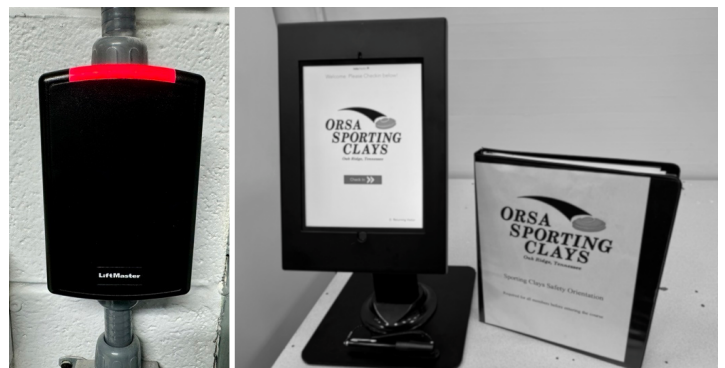
When the course is crowded, groups of 3 & 4 must use 1 cart.

## Attention Wild Bunch Enthusiasts

Monthly SASS Wild Bunch Action Shooting Matches begin on Thursday October 10 at 9:30 am on the Action Pistol Range. The Single Action Shooting Society (SASS) serves as the governing and sanctioning body of the sport of Cowboy Action and Wild Bunch shooting to ensure safety and consistency in competitions worldwide.

American history buffs and serious shooters alike agree the use of vintage firearms, authentic costuming, unique targets, and fast action make Wild Bunch Action Shooting one of the most interesting of all shooting sports for both spectator and contestant.

The Wild Bunch Match consists of five stages using fire arms typical of those used in the old west during the early 1900's - Pistols are typically the Colt Model 1911 in 45 ACP, shotguns typically the Winchester Model 1897 or Model 12 in 12 gauge, rifles are typically the Winchester Model 1873 in 45 Colt.

Each stage is a different scenario of steel targets and multiple pistol, rifle and shotgun rounds shot on the clock for best overall time.

Contestants are organized by category, the categories

at ORSA Wild Bunch Matches are: Modern and Senior Modern, Traditional and Senior Traditional, and Open.

Available on the internet at the SASS website, the SASS Wild Bunch Shooters Handbook provides additional details on the Modern and Traditional categories, specific rules, regulations and general guidelines.

At ORSA the Senior categories are designed for folks 65 years and older. The Open category at ORSA is designed for those who want to shoot fire arms other than those listed in the SASS Handbook.

**All participants and spectators must wear safety glasses and ear protection.**

The only projectiles allowed at the Wild Bunch Matches must be lead - no hard cast, jacketed, or steel bullets or shot.

Wild Bunch Action Shooting is a dynamic, fun, fast paced action shooting sport designed for the shooter. Once you shoot your first Wild Bunch stage, you will be just as enthusiastic as participating in the sport as we are!
